Get Your Kicks On Route 66! Peggy Portner Go West Young Man - through Texas, New Mexico \& California

## TEXAS

Fun fact: If you've seen Pixar's Cars, you've seen the Texas portion of Route 66!
U.S. Route 66 crosses northern Texas from Texola OK, across the Texas Panhandle, to Glenrio NM, where it was designated in 1926 and decommissioned in 1985. Travelers were greeted at the First/Last Motel in Glenrio and eventually arrived at the "Midpoint of Route 66" in the tiny town of Adrian, population 149. Flo of Flo's V-8 Diner in Cars is based on Fran Houser, the now-retired former owner; the Mia and Tia characters are based on two sisters at the Midpoint Café. The latter calls itself the geographic mid-point between Los Angeles and Chicago on 66 . Signs display the 1,139 -mile distance to each original US 66 endpoint, and the café's slogan is "When you're here, you're halfway there".

Amarillo is the only major city on the Texas portion of US 66. The Cadillac Range mountains in Cars were inspired by the Cadillac Ranch; the Tex Dinoco character mimics the stretched, longhorn Cadillac vehicles at Amarillo's Big Texan Steak Ranch. The Ranchotel, a tourist court built in 1940 and designed to resemble a Texas ranch, was one of sixty-eight Route 66 lodgings operating in Amarillo by 1953. The building still stands in good condition but is now used as apartments. Shamrock has restored the Tower Station and U-Drop Inn Café as a visitor center; the Tower Station's distinctive architecture is copied as Ramone's body shop in 'Cars'.


## NEW MEXICO

Officially opened January 3, 1927 after political maneuvering by the Santa Fe Ring, Republican businessmen and officials, Rte. 66 ran through Los Lunas, Santa Fe and Albuquerque. Ten years later it was moved to the shorter route along central NM; the new alignments were known as the Laguna Cut-off and the Santa Rosa Cut-off, east and west of Albuquerque.

Mostly mountainous, 66 in NM passes through several Indian reservations: the Native American Pueblo of Santo Domingo (Kewa Pueblo) in Santo Domingo and the Pueblo of Laguna in Laguna. Albuquerque's 1939 Maisel's Indian Trading Post, which employed hundreds of native craftspeople, reopened in the 1980s and still operates today. As the new Route 66 brought increased traffic to NM, motels sprouted like cacti, beckoning weary travelers. One motel in Tucumcari advertised "2000 motel rooms" on signs, urging "Tucumcari tonite!" Also in Tucumcari is the 12 -room Blue Swallow Motel, founded in 1939 and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, famous for its unique neon signs. The Motel Safari, recently restored, is a NM icon. Built in 1959 by Chester Dohrer, it features mid-century modern retro design with "Doo Wop" or "Googie" styled architecture. Look for boomerangs, holes in cinder blocks, counter stacked bricks protruding from the façade and whimsical metal cylinders that light up at night. Its famous camel atop the neon sign pays tribute to the U.S. Camel Corps, in that area in the 1800s, surveying a future national road system.

Finally, and most unique: a stretch of NM 333 in Tijeras is a musical road*, with rumble strips that play "America the Beautiful". (*A musical road is a road, or part of a road, which when driven over causes a tactile vibration and audible rumbling transmitted through the wheels into the car body in the form of a musical tune).

## CALIFORNIA

Covering 315 miles in CA, Rte. 66 runs from Needles through the Mojave Desert to Barstow, terminating at the Santa Monica Pier in Los Angeles. The seminal tale of the "Mother Road", Steinbeck's Grapes of Wrath describes a large, primitive riverside campground, sighted upon arriving in Needles, California from Arizona. John Ford's 1940 film version of "The Grapes of Wrath" dubbed the site 'Carty's Camp cabins', now a deteriorating ghost tourist court) and the adjacent 66 Motel.

The 1924 Aztec Hotel in Monrovia, a National Historic Landmark in the San Gabriel Valley, is notable for its Mayan Revival architecture. One of three restored Wigwam Motels (see October 2019 Calls ' $n$ ' Cues) accommodates motorists in San Bernardino near Rialto.

Fittingly, the state features two museums about the Route's history, California Route 66 Museum in the former Red Rooster Café in Victorville, and the Barstow Route 66 "Mother Road" Museum in the town's former Harvey House Railroad Depot. (See https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/List_of_Route_66_mu seums\#Route_66_Mother_Road_Museum)

To complete the journey along this fabled route, listen to the 1977 Eagles song "Hotel California", which opens with a reference to Route 66: "On a dark desert highway, cool wind in my hair, Warm smell of colitas rising up through the air, Up ahead in the distance, I saw a shimmering light, My head grew heavy and my sight grew dim, I had to stop for the night". The band's Don Felder comments: 'Everybody had driven into Los Angeles on what used to be Route 66. And as you drive in through the desert at night, you can see the glow of Los Angeles from a hundred miles away. The closer and closer you get, you start seeing all of these images, and these things pounded into our heads: the stars on Hollywood Boulevard, movie stars, palm trees, beaches and girls in bikinis".

## CHOREO CORNER

## Was I right to go left?

As callers we often expect dancers to know their right from their left. But the fact is many dancers have a problem reacting to a right or left call. Some dancers are lefthanded. Some have not been in an environment where they have to think about right and left. And some dancers just naturally are confused. From one of my dancers, "some people have problems with reversing images, "d" vs "b", or " q " vs " "". These dancers have learned to cope, but still may have problems with the commands "Left" and "Right".

I used to think this strange, until I think back in my life and realize I have a problem in my mind between white and yellow. Don't ask me why, I can see them perfectly fine and if I stop a minute, I don't have any problem telling them apart. But in the heat of battle, or whatever I get confused.

Consider this sequence which is almost guaranteed to break down a square:

Allemande Left, Alamo Style and Balance, BOYS Run Right, BOYS Run Left, GIRLS Run Right, GIRLS Run Left, Right \& Left Grand.

Why is this hard? Well there is a lot of moving dancers for one thing (everyone is moving). There is a lot of right and lefts going on, and they are not the same for everyone. To wit:

From the Alamo Ring, when the boys run right around a girl, the girl has to move to the right into the space vacated by the boy. Next when the boy runs left around the next girl, she still has to move to the right into the space vacated by the boy. So while the boy is going right and left, the girl is going right and right. All right?

But then it gets even harder because the boys are usually not as adept as the girls if they are going a different way than the girl. This is especially for round dancers where the girls learn to go left when the boy goes right, sometimes, but not all the times.

So now the girls run right while the boy move right and the girls run left while the boys move right. Finally, everyone has to turn right to face their partner for a right and left grand. Wow.

There are many dance formations where the command "Right" is assisted by the fact the dancer is facing someone else who is helping. Consider Right \& Left Grand, there is your partner holding out a hand to shake
with you. You don't need to know it's a right hand, only that you need to take it. Some moves are ingrained into your muscle memory, Right \& Left Thru for example. Other calls require the individual dancer to do something by themselves (although other dancer can do a lot to help with a slight nudge).

One example of this is lines facing out. If the command includes a direction like Chase Right, then the direction challenged dancer is less likely to succeed.

Part of the problem is the way some dancers are taught. For instance, we can teach Chase Right two different ways. Consider the Callerlab "official" definition:

CHASE RIGHT - Starting formation - Two Couples Back-to-Back. TIMING - 6

Each right-hand dancer does an exaggerated Zoom action, moving into the position previously occupied by the right-hand dancer behind him, to finish facing in the same direction as when he started the Zoom action.

The net result is the same as if the right-hand dancer had done a right face U Turn Back \& Box Circulate twice. The left-hand dancer follows ("Chases") the right-hand dancer by doing a Box Circulate two positions. The call finishes in a Box Circulate formation.

For a normal couple, another way to explain this is: The Girl turns away from her partner and everyone Split Circulates twice.

Most often this works OK because of muscle memory and the realization it ends in a right-hand wave (with the other dancers). Left Chase is often less successful - or at least there will be a pause while everyone thinks about it, because (in a normal couple) the boy has to turn left (away from his partner), and everyone does a Split Circulate twice ending in a left-hand wave. We don't call it as much and the muscle memory is not as strong. For a halfsashayed couple, the difficulty level is even harder.

Another challenge is the call Swing Thru from a lefthand wave formation. This is not normal (e.g. how we learned) and unless someone calls "right" dancers may try to start with there left hand (the center and end dancers).

For my last example, consider the Advance call; Right Roll To A Wave. Believe it or not, this is an easy call to explain, but can be a hard call to dance (hence why it's on the Advance list).

The short definition from Callerlab is:

Right (Left) Roll to a Wave Formation: From a tandem, back-to-back dancers, or facing dancers:

The leads right (left)-face U-Turn Back, and all (Left) Touch.

OMG. First, for now ignore the (Left) in parenthesis. The call is either Right Roll To A Wave or Left Roll To A Wave. We are going to look at Right Roll To A Wave. Once again, like last month, this is a call we can easily call at the BASIC program level. "The Lead dancers do a right (or left) U-Turn Back and Everybody step to a wave (or touch)"

So why is this hard? First there is no getting around the term Right (or Left) Roll. Second, it's not REALLY a roll, it's a U-Turn Back. Third, you have to immediately determine if you are a leader and need to do the U-Turn Back, because if you're not (a leader), you are just going to step forward and touch (or make a wave).

The call can be called from a Trade By formation, in which case everybody is a leader and everyone does the UTurn Back and extend to a wave. And here is the really hard one: From a Completed Double Pass Thru formation we can call Right Roll To A Wave, TWICE.

If you have a problem with left and rights, and leaders
and trailers, this call is not for you. First, the End dancer (leaders) U-Turn Back (to the right) and step to a righthand wave. We now have two parallel ocean waves. The SECOND Right Roll To A Wave call has a roll reversal for the dancers. Those who were previously leaders are now trailers and vice versa. So a different set of dancers does the U-Turn Back and extends to a right-hand title wave.

And of course we can do the whole thing left handed too, with Left Roll To A Wave.

If you are a right/left challenged dancer, make sure your caller is aware of it. And don't be in such a hurry to move, think about it for second or so.

If you are a Caller with right/left challenged dancers, consider other ways of calling. For example: Run around your Partner, Run to the far end of the line (for cross run). Or emphasis the word right (or left) and give the dancers time to think about it, like "with your left hand, trade".

Dancers can help everyone in their square by first holding (touching) hands whenever you can and secondly, by slight (very slight) nudges to your partner in the correct direction. Working together, we can ensure everyone is successful in the square.
