For all three callers, I recommend that checks sent directly to them rather than using Go-Fund-Me or similar. While such sites may not charge fees, there will be an ~3% fee to the credit card processing organization. Direct remittances don't have to pay that fee. When deciding how much you can afford, remember that you will not have to pay for the VASARDA or MDSDF conventions or this year's National convention

For the Square & Round Dancing community *so far, so good.* While we do have one obituary in this issue, I can not find any indication that she was a victim of COVID-19. That said, please continue letting me know about any deaths in the community - I have no other way of learning about them.

### 62<sup>nd</sup> WASCA Spring Festival "WASCA's Dancing Through the Cherry Blossoms."

We are getting ready to be "Dancing Through the Cherry Blossoms" at our WASCA 2021 Festival. Our registration form is on the wascaclubs.com site, which you can print out and mail in to get registered and make a room reservation. The official D.C. festival starts as our festival ends, and you might want to make arrangements to see some of the activities that will be happening at that time.

We are really disappointed that they cancelled this year's Cherry Blossom Festival in D.C., but they did manage to show last year's parade and activities one afternoon on the T.V. I wish I had known about it earlier, because I only got to see about half of the parade. The Washington D.C.'s annual National Cherry Blossom Festival commemorates the 1912 gift of 3,000 cherry trees from Tokyo to D.C. and is such a popular attraction that you will want to plan to attend the 2021 springtime festival. The Cherry Blossom fever hits during peak bloom of the Yoshino cherry trees around the Tidal Basin. You can see other blossoms at the U.S. National Arboretum and The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. Other countries also have received Cherry trees from Tokyo, and you can see some spectacular sites in Canada by clicking on the links that are posted in Peggy Portner's article. The D.C. Festival features creative and diverse activities that promote traditional and contemporary arts and culture. natural beauty and the environment, and community spirit and youth education, the majority of which are free and open to the public. Signature Festival events include the Opening Ceremony, the

Blossom Kite Festival, and the National Cherry Blossom Festival Parade. There are over 150 daily cultural performances by local, national and international entertainers, sports competitions, and so much more.

We are really excited about our callers and cuers for the festival, which you can find pictured on the back of our registration form. The callers include Jerry Biggerstaff, Jeremy Butler, Bill Harrison, Eric Henerlau, Tom Miller, Mike Sikorsky, Jerry Story and Buddy Weaver. Our cuers will be Wayne & Barbara Blackford, Sally & Bob Nolen, Marie & Randy Preskitt, and Tammy & Curt Worlock. There will also be some Line Dancing prompted by Donna & Doug Riley.

We hope that you will enjoy our theme for 2021, and we are looking for anyone interested in helping with artwork and decorations. There is a lot of beautiful cherry blossom material out there right now for those that want to dress up for the theme at our March 18 - 20, 2021, "Dancing Through the Cherry Blossoms" festival.

We now have eight clubs signed up for theme dances, so please contact our theme dance coordinator, Janet Kelley, at FestivalThemeDance@WASCAClubs.com and set up your theme dance date. 

### Dancing through the Cherry Blossoms

O Canada



While 'dancing through the cherry blossoms', we first visit our closest neighbor, Canada. The author was inspired by the photo above from a close friend in Vancouver.

### Vancouver

In the early 1930's, Japan gave hundreds of trees to Vancouver to thank the Japanese Canadiens who served in World War I. Today the city boasts over 40,000 trees.

Most of the **Vancouver Cherry Blossom Festival** (April 2-26) was cancelled due to covid-19, but in better times, its Tree Walk is the highlight of the Festival. Their website (https://www.vcbf.ca/?pmo=VAN) shows photos of many species: 'Shirotae', 'Umineko', Sendai-shidare', 'Takasago', 'Mikuruma-gaeshi'; 'Ukon' and 'Kanzan'. Other usual events are The Big Picnic, a concert and haiku invitational.

**Queen Elizabeth Park**, the city's horticultural jewel, is a 52 hectare (128 acre) park sitting 152 metres (500 ft.) above sea level; it's the highest point in the city and is located in its geographic center. The Bloedel Conservatory is a domed paradise with 120 free-flying birds and 500 exotic plants and flowers. In addition, the Park features a landscaped quarry garden, an arboretum, sculptures and recreational opportunities: tennis, lawn bowling, pitch and putt. The Celebration Pavilion, a popular event (think *wed-ding*) choice, has sliding walls that open to a patio and garden area. (https://vancouver.ca/parks-recreation-culture/queen-elizabeth-park.aspx?pmo=VAN)

**Stanley Park** is the city's first and largest urban park, a green oasis in an urban setting. It houses Canada's largest aquarium and offers 400 hectares (1½ sq. miles) of trails, beaches, rainforest, and wildlife, alongside natural, cultural and historic landmarks. (https://vancouver.ca/parks-recreation-culture/stanley-park.aspx?pmo=VAN)

### Victoria

The capital city of British Columbia (B.C.) is one of the oldest cities in the Pacific Northwest. Known as 'The Garden City', its temperate, snow-free climates is ideal for the cherry blossom trees, especially against the turn-of-the-century Victorian buildings. Victoria is also the biking capital of Canada, offering trails through both downtown areas and neighborhoods with masses of blooming trees .(https://www.victoriabuzz.com/2016/02/your-guide-to-the-top-areas-to-see-the-blossoms-in-bloom/?pmo=BC)

### Edmonton

Moving east, Edmonton, the capital of Alberta, famous for farms, orchards and vineyards, sees the cherry blossoms in May. One website claims that the George F. Hustler Memorial Plaza has over 200 different varieties. Other viewing sites are the French Quarter, the Victoria Promenade and the Alberta Legislature grounds. (Disclaimer: the author could not locate photos online).

### Toronto

Further east, Toronto succumbs annually to the Japanese tradition of Sakura Hanami, cherry blossom viewing. The blossom peak in late April-early May. Their blossoms are a recent acquisition, with a similar history as elsewhere: in 1959, the Japanese ambassador to Canada, Toru-Hagiwara, presented Toronto with 2,000 Somei-Yoshino Sakura trees on behalf of the citizens of Tokyo. The gift was in appreciation for Canada's welcoming Japanese-Canadians who relocated to the city after World War II\*. From 2000 to 2012, the consulate's Sakura Project has planted an additional 3,000 trees all over Ontario. The High Park Nature Center (https://highparknaturecentre.com/2/cherryblossom) and Sakura in High Park (https://www.sakurainhighpark.com/) cancelled their events this year, but have many beautiful photos on their websites.

\*The city, the provincial capital of Ontario and the country's most populous city, is an important immigrant destination. Fifty percent of residents belong to a visible minority population group and 200 distinct ethnic groups are represented.

### Ottawa

The capital of Canada is more famous for its tulips, given in gratitude for sheltering the royal Dutch family during WWII, but cherry blossoms abound in Central Experimental Farm National Historic Site's Arboretum (video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uLdbsOTA9z0), Dows Lake and in the wide open spaces outside the city.


### 70th NSDC - Jackson 2021



Now I have to think, how did they get there, who put them there, and what do I do with these long lost, forgotten things? I've put three years worth of family pictures into albums. I've written letters that I've meant to write for the last year. I've even broken out the ironing board. Remember that thing? Now I am racking my brain to think of things to do. Let's see. Why don't I do the things that always catch me off guard or cause a panic at the last minute. Of course, sewing. I am sure that are lots of shirts, blouses, slacks, pants, skirts, dresses and coats that have loose or missing buttons. What a great time to go through our wardrobes and find anything with missing buttons or a button hanging on by a single thread, then go through my button box. (Don't you have a button box?) ### Couple Dancing with Phantoms, or "How am I going to remember how to dance after COVID-19"?

Spring is here and summer is coming. Perhaps we will begin to move back to a normal life soon but in truth, nobody knows. The future of school opening is hazy at best – certainly not this school year – and how/when next year is still unknown. Of course, many clubs rely on the schools for a place to dance. Lincolnia Senior Center, and presumably other Senior Centers, follow the school systems.

I hear many dancer comments on how they can maintain square dance proficiency during the pandemic. Let's face it folks, you are NOT going to forget how to dance from a few weeks or months of not dancing. On the other hand, you may be missing dancing. Ah ha! We can do something about that!Assuming you and your spouse, partner, family etc. are social distancing from others, you still have yourselves to enjoy. Personally, I am so enjoying my 6 month old grand-daughter who stays with us during the week so here parents can telecommute from my wellequipped computer cave. But did you know, you can STILL square dance at home. Here is how:

The basic concept is a mini-square, or two couple dancing. You most likely (almost certainly) encountered mini-squares when you were learning to dance. It is much easier to keep track of things when there are only 4 people involved and many square dance moves can be practiced with 4 dancers. But what happens when there is only two of you? We are going to reach out to the Callerlab "C" program for the answer, which is "phantom dancers", sometimes referred to as "imaginary dancers".

I'm going to give you some simple routines that you can practice at home, but you are not limited to these. You too, can be a caller and make up your own sequences from the list below. Hint: It helps if after each call, if you and your partner both point to the imaginary dancers.Not interested in being a caller? Not to worry, Buddy Weaver has a solution for you. podcast On his page, https://buddyweavermusic.podbean.com Buddy had three recordings sessions for a single couple. Enterprising dancers have already posted YouTube videos of these routines. Check them out at: https://tinyurl.com/buddyonecouple-1 and https://tinyurl.com/buddyonecouple-2But first, give these routines a try and see how you like one couple dancing.
