# The Ealitor's Desk 

Welcome to Fall Everybody
It is the start of what would have been our new dance season. As shown on our cover this is a new dance season in more than one way. While in person dances have been canceled to include next year's WASCA festival, virtual / online / distance dancing is thriving. WASCA area callers are scheduling dances several nights each week. Several are listed in the Calendar of Events. There is also a private Facebook group named Virtual Square Dances. (www.facebook.com/groups/VirtualSquareDances). This group was established by a pair of callers to managing virtual square dances. It has almost 2000 members . It assumes that members already know Modern Western Square Dancing and. lists events for almost every evening. Being online, they are attended by dancers from around the world. Be sure you check the time zone associated with the dance time. It is easy to join this private group: all they ask is the name(s) of club(s) that you dance with.

These dances are facilitated by devices which have both cameras and microphones. After reading all the emails about them, and since I had neither on my 8 year old laptop, I decided to break down and buy a new one. While I know that laptops are good for online dances, I'm not sure how well smart phones would work,

I am aware of two video meeting platforms in use by WASCA area callers. The most popular is zoom.com. While it has a "basic" free plan, that plan's limitations make it unsatisfactory for virtual dancing. For online dancing callers need to pay between $\$ 15 /$ month and $\$ 150 /$ year for a "pro" plan which allows up to 100 dancers with unlimited time meetings. The other meeting platform is jitsi.org. This is a collection of free and open-source video conferencing software for web sites. At meet.jit.si This software has been interfaced to allow unrestricted free meetings Its biggest problem is that while free, there is no tech support which makes it more difficult to use.

That segues nicely to my plea for this month. Since someone, typically the caller, has paid for the platform being used, please contribute at least $\$ 10$ to any tip jar present. This is particularly important when one of the callers is a full time caller. They need the money.

Finally I want to announce that Calls'N'Cues will be published bimonthly until we get back to in person dancing.

# From the <br> WASCA President's Corner

## Cancellation of 2021 WASCA Spring Festival

We regret to inform you that the WASCA Spring Festival scheduled for March 18-20, 2021 has been cancelled. This action was taken by a unanimous decision of the Board of Directors and followed a discussion about the potential danger to attending dancers and supporting calling/cueing staff that might exist in March 2021. While it seems early to make this decision, the Board has experienced the unpredictability of the Covid-19 virus and its effect on our desire to return to normal dance activity. Also, in cancelling at this point, our contracted liabilities have been minimized and this enables us to retain sufficient funds to continue operating and able to hold Festivals in the future.

As many of you recall the 2020 WASCA Spring Festival (scheduled for March 19-21, 2020) was cancelled on short notice. The WASCA festival is typically attended by around 1000 dancers from more than 25 states and around $80 \%$ of our attendees come from other states. As of the first week of March 2020 there had been no reported cases in the state of Virginia, however, we did have dancers coming from states with reported cases. The first Covid-19 case in Virginia was reported on March 7 and two additional cases on March 8. More cases resulted in the governor of Virginia declaring a state of emergency and restricting large events the following week.

In looking back at March 2020 we believe that the decision to cancel was in the best interests of the attending dancers and staff and was the correct decision. Everyone has been following the news on progress against Covid-19. Progress as well as prediction of progress has not been totally positive. For example, on March 29, 2020 Dr, Fauci spoke of projections of 100,000 to 200,000 deaths. On April 9, 2020 we were pleased to hear that Dr. Fauci had revised these numbers down to 60,000. However by August 2020 we are above 160,000 deaths.

It is clear that no one can predict the situation in March 2021. At the present date, we could not legally hold the Festival in Virginia and community spread appears higher in Virginia than in the home states of some of our dancers. It seems clear that the set of solutions needed to return to safe dance activity does not exist today and may still not exist in March 2021.

While it was disappointing to make this decision we will look forward to normal dance activity returning during 2021 and a great Spring Festival on March 17-19, 2022. Come and join us - it will be glorious!

As we learn of any other "virtual/distance" round dancing opportunities, we will convey them to everyone in subsequent RDTA messages or through the WASCA dancers e-mail.

We will look for safe and prudent opportunities to join all of you on the dance floor, hopefully early next year, and will inform everyone of such opportunities in future messages.

I still cannot see out of my left eye because the gas they put in there to stabilize the eye takes 6 weeks To 8 weeks to dissipate

At that point I was already in rehab learning how to walk again. I stood up one time in the Walker and actually had my left leg collapse and I fell. Fortunately, I did not hurt myself.

He did some digging and finally figured out I had MRSA In every organ in my body and floating in my bloodstream. I also had double pneumonia. They took me out of the Corona virus unit and put me in intensive care and Pumped me with antibiotics. I immediately went into sepsis and it was very dicey the 1st few

## CHOREO CORNER with Dick Otis

## Virtual Dancing part 2

In my July/August issue of Choreo Corner I discussed the new COVID-19 induced program of Virtual Dancing. We've come a long way in six months and I hope you enjoy some of my observations and thoughts.

Many square dance callers called for decades or more. However, the transition to calling a virtual dance is just as challenging for them as it is for a new caller (well almost anyway). Most callers use sight and/or modules to call an actual dance. Most virtual callers (including me) are using written material to call.

Why you ask? Most virtual dancers are dancing at home with their dance partner (e.g. one couple) or in some cases one person in a mini-square formation. This is difficult for one couple and extremely difficult for one person. After getting past the "Zoom" technical difficulties I discussed in the last issue, two things are required for virtual dancing success.

One is that the caller must be able to help the dancers by constantly reminding them what formation they are in and where the "phantom dancers" (the dancers you can't see) are in that formation. We use mini-squares because that limits the number of "phantom" dancers. With one real couple there is one phantom couple. For single dancers there are three phantoms - their partner and the phantom couple. If we tried to call a full square, you'd have six phantom dancers - virtually impossible :)

Writing material makes it easier to keep the dancers informed of what is happening.

While it is possible to sight call a virtual dance, the difficultly lies in that most dances have 40,50 or more connections. Zoom limits personal accounts to 100 connections (corporate accounts are unlimited). In six months, l've only seen one dance (Tom Miller and Bill Harrison) hit that limitation. On the other hand people can (and do) log in from around the globe. Gary Felton and I have an Advance Class with dancers from Japan, Australia and around the country.

The second thing required for success (except for on-line classes) are dancers who are experienced dancers. Experienced in this case, means that the dancers understand the definition of a call and can visualize it's execution without another dancer available to give them visual cues. For instance, if you have a phantom partner, facing the other couple who is your original partner dancing with a phantom, and the caller says "Right \& Left Thru" you are either turning a phantom partner around or being turned around by a phantom. In either case, the phantom is not going to help you execute the call.

The caller will help you by ensuring that you end up with your (original) partner as much as possible. The easiest case is you are coupled with your partner. The next easiest case is you are separated from your original partner for one call. The hardest case is you are separated from your partner for multiple calls. The caller will help by keeping you aware of your formation, where your (original) partner is and where the phantom dancers are located.This means you need to understand the basic formation names (couple, mini-wave, waves, and types of lines, plus the concept of leaders and trailers.

Virtual dancing has some significant advantages however. First, you can participate without sharing your video. This means if you really mess up, nobody is going to see you do so. However, it also means the caller can't help you specifically. Secondly, even if you DO share your video, the odds are nobody is watching you because they are
busy dancing. You should determine before you start, if the host is recording the dance and if the host is "live streaming" the dance on Facebook etc. Please, please remember to check to see if your connection is muted before having an "offline" discussion with your partner.


Just for fun, I asked Ed to include a photo of my calling setup (see above). It has evolved over the past six months from one computer using a WIFI connection, to a new computer with two large monitors, a 100MB direct connect to the internet, a separate laptop to generate music, and a new studio quality balance audio interface (a Focusrite Scarlett 4i4).

The multiple monitor allows me to watch two couples (or one couple and the gallery view) while I'm calling. The audio interface allows me to independently adjust the volume (balance) of music and microphone It also provides a separate headphone volume for me to monitor what l'm calling. As a result, there is no delay or interference between the voice and the music, and I can adjust both separately as judged by the dancers.

If you haven't tried virtual square dancing yet, you
owe it to yourself to give it a try. There are dances and classes available at every level from basic through challenge. Most dances do not have a fee - although many callers (especially full-time callers who are out of work) have a "tip jar" where, if you want, you can give what you want. Tips are appreciated but not expected or required to participate.

The Club met for socializing through a Zoom call in July to check up on how everyone was getting along. Of course, not everyone was set up to do Zoom. Ben Brown has done virtual square dancing via Zoom, and several of our members have tried out dancing with phantoms. This proved to be rather challenging so in some instances two couples got together and danced in mini-squares to Ben's calls.

The Club met for socializing through a Zoom call in July to check up on how everyone was getting along.

Dancing via Zoom with phantoms and mini-squares has raised the question as to whether the Club could get together and dance with a live caller who tailored calls for phantoms and mini-squares. Consideration is being given to what regulations would be needed for the Club to get together to socialize and dance safely.

The following are some of the considerations. The dance location would have to be large, and the Community Center Gym where Lake of the Woods normally dances is large. Pairs of chairs that have been sanitized would need to be socially distanced along the walls for couples who want to talk and/ or just watch. Persons dancing would need to dance with family members or persons with whom they have had regular contact. Squares would need to be ten feet apart. Everyone would need to be in good health, and not have had a temperature or other illness symptoms, or exposure to high risk situations in the fourteen days prior to the event. Participants must not have had exposure to a COVID infected person. Fourteen days should have passed if persons have travel out of the area or out of the country. Masks and social distancing would be required at all times. Everyone would supply their own water or refreshment. No food would be served in order to avoid passing the virus in that manner.

At an actual dance with a caller, persons would dance as phantoms or in mini-squares. It would be a good ideas to ask the caller to conduct the activity as a work shop to help dancers get accustomed to this different style of dancing. All dancing would be conducted without touching. That means dancers would execute the calls by changing their positions, but not actually using any hand contact. Following each tip dancers would either wash their hands or use hand sanitizer especially if by chance they touched another person's hand.

This also means that during the period while COVID 19 is active any club get together would have to be restricted to members. The Club would not be able to entertain guests. It is our hope that everyone will wear a mask, socially distance, wash hands, and use hand sanitizer. Please stay safe so that we can all be together at square dance functions in the future.
