The Editor's Desk

The pandemic continues

When I started this issue I was feeling very optimistic about the future. The first emergency use authorization for the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine had just been issued, and initial vaccinations were occurring with great publicity. The Moderna vaccine was about a week behind in the approval process. The powers that be were promising that 20 million people would receive vaccinations by 1 January. I had hopes that I could be vaccinated by April.

In the square and round dance world things were looking up. VASARDA was planning to hold the Virginia State Convention and the 70th National Squared Dance Convention to be held in Jackson Mississippi issues a press release notifying everybody that they were "still on". I have been registered for some time, and I started hoping I would be able to go.

But the closer we got to the New Year, the more realism began to intrude. Cases (and deaths) began to surge to record levels. As I write this column on New Year's Eve the U.S. is approaching 20 million cases with over 340 thousand deaths. One out of every thousand Americans has died. Forecasts are for January to get even worse. Americans seem to be unwilling to follow recommended safety precautions - the Sunday after Christmas saw the greatest number of airplane passengers so far this pandemic. And according to the news, the expected 20 million vaccinations has shrunk to barely 2 million.

Why am I bringing all this up? It is to request strongly that we redouble our efforts to stay safe. Follow all the recommended safeguards and procedures. I really would like to get back dancing, and I really do not want to see any of you readers be the last person to contract (and possibly die from) COVID-19. I NEED PARTNERS TO DANCE WITH

We hope that all of you had a wonderful Holiday and are looking forward to a much better year in 2021. As we start to deal with the problems of restarting dancing, we suggest being extra CARE-FUL and PATIENT.

Our suggestion of being patient about dance events (especially large events) is driven by what we found while looking for large dance events that might have started back to dancing too quickly. One example is a headline from the Myrtle Beach Sun News which read "A month after SC shag gathering, at least 5 dead and 20 test positive for COVID-19" (dated OCTOBER 23, 2020). This appeared to be a good sized event involving more than 800 dancers.

On dance-forums.com (October 9, 2020) we found the following post related to this event and provide how a dancer views this event.

"Tony Azar said on Facebook: Sad news - Prayers for Everyone. More than 60 Dancers with COVID-19 It's hard to believe that so many Dancers have Covid-19 after going to a Dance Event in September 2020. Our Dance Community needs to be more Patient. If you went to Shaggin'

on Main from September 23 - 27, 2020, Please go get tested & Stay safe. "

A look on Facebook provided an updated post from Tony.


"... More than 125 Dancers are infected with COVID-19 & More than 15 Deaths.

Numbers keep growing, all I know is people privately tracking it. .. Dancers came from Florida, Kentucky, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Tennessee, NC, SC, Etc... I know everybody is excited about getting back to dancing, but just need to be patient... My Heart Goes Out To Everyone!"

Again, our suggestion is to be patient and careful.

On the positive side, the recent availability of a vaccine would indicate that life will gradually start to return to something like normal in the year ahead so we just have to hang in there a little longer.

Take care, be safe and we hope that 2021 will be a good year for everyone.



Single Square Dancers USA will be celebrating 50th years of dancing SSDUSA's 50th Dance-A-Rama Festival To Be Held on Labor Day Weekend of 2021.



Since the COVID-19 virus forced Single Square Dancers USA to cancel our 50th Dance-A-Rama festival that was scheduled for Labor Day weekend of 2020, the SSDUSA Board has secured a venue to celebrate our 50 years of dancing with a final Dance-A-Rama festival with a one year gap. We have signed a contract with the Airport Holiday Inn in Des Moines, Iowa to hold our Dance-A-Rama festival there on Labor Day weekend of 2021. Amenities at this hotel include refrigerators, microwaves, and free Wi Fi in the rooms. They have a full service restaurant and a free shuttle that runs within a two mile radius of the hotel. You can use Uber, Lyft, or Taxis to get to the downtown or other places in the local area. There is plenty of free parking at the hotel and a free shuttle (Keck) from/to the nearby Des Moines airport which is just minutes from the hotel, basically just down the street. Dancers may even want to find time to enjoy the hotels unique Tropical Courtyard with indoor pool and whirlpool. Some of you may remember this hotel from when we held our Dance-A-Rama there in 2012. The hotel has done extensive remodeling since then and all dancing will be on one level this year. Iowa's State Square Dance Convention will be held there in the spring of 2021

We are pleased and excited that we will still have the entire outstanding line-up of callers and cuers that were to entertain us in 2020: Callers: Jack Pladdys (OH), Tim Tyl (TX), Tom Davis (OH) and Travis Cook (KY), and Cuers: Phyllis Burdette (OH) and Bonnie Lawrence (IN) (with Bonnie also teaching and leading line dances).

I will serve as Chairperson in charge of our festival, and am excited to welcome you back to Des Moines. I am already busy looking for places for us to go on tours. Take a look below at some of the interesting and beautiful sites that Iowa has to offer. The Capital, Sculpture Park and our Art Center are free. There is a free shuttle that operates in the downtown loop (from the Capitol to the Sculpture Park). Come early or stay late and see what you didn't get to see in 2012 or when the National was here in 2016.

Jerry Lee Story

Jerry Lee Story age 65 of Fairfield, passed away Saturday, December 19, 2020, at the University of Iowa Hospital and Clinic.

Jerry was born June 21, 1955, to Kenneth and Marian (Hammond) Story in Keokuk, IA. He married Kristine Sue Laux on July 25, 1976 in Fairfield, Iowa.

Jerry began calling in 1969 at the age of 14. In 1976, he married his high school sweetheart, Kristy, who was in his second beginner class. Two children, Joshua & Jacob, soon followed and his career picked up momentum.

He found himself touring full time calling dances and festivals coast to coast and around the world. Early in his career he traveled to Saudi Arabia 10 consecutive years calling for several Western companies where many recordings of Jerry's calling and teaching were made & distributed throughout Sweden and around the world. Due to this distribution, Modern Western Square Dancing exploded in Sweden and other places around the world. Many young Swedish callers learned to call from these recordings and are still calling today. Jerry and Kristy raised their sons in Mission, Texas while operating a very exciting square dancing program at the Peppermint Palace in El Valle Del Sol RV Park since 1983.

Jerry is co-owner of Royal Records and has numerous hit records. His gospel CD "Wings of a Dove", recorded in Nashville, sold thousands of copies worldwide. Jerry is proud to have been part of the McAllen Callers Association & promoting McAllen, Texas as the Square Dance Capital of the World by holding the "World's Largest Beginner Classes." He also served as a Board of Governors member in CALLERLAB and is dedicated to the preservation of Modern Western Square Dancing. He says the secret will be creating a more sustainable direction for the activity. Jerry lives and calls in Fairfield, lowa and is co-owner of Pride Resorts RV camp in Maggie Valley, NC. Jerry called for the WASCA Festival in 2016, 2017 & 2019. He had been scheduled to call in 2021.

From Steve Kopman

I wanted to share my best and worst calling experience of all time that happened to involve Jerry.

Best: I had received a cassette tape of Jerry calling Fisherman's Luck from a dancer. I listened to it with amazement. How could anyone talk that fast? Where did he take a breath? I kept listening and listening and started to copy Jerry's version of the singing call. I practiced it so many times I got tired of singing the melody and started practice calling it with Jerry in harmony, word for word. Now if you've ever heard Fisherman's Luck this was an unimaginative challenge.

Not long after I was booked to call a festival in St. Louis that Jerry was also featured. Sometime on Saturday we were slated to call in the A2 hall together. At the completion of the hour I said to Jerry, let's call a singing call and put on Fisherman's Luck. Jerry's eyes got HUGE when he heard the introduction and I whispered to just call it like he normally does. And from the very 1st words "well, the 4 little ladies gonna chain the ring" we called word for word in harmony. This was, without a doubt, the highlight of my calling career. First, I got to call with Jerry Story a legend in our business, and I got to surprise him with one of the songs that he was most famous for. At the completion I was emotionally exhausted and we looked at each other and just knew this was something special.

Worst: I signed up to call at the National Square dance convention in Salt Lake City. Prior to the convention I received my calling assignments and was thrilled to see I had an 8:40P spot in the Plus hall. Now, Kopman's don't often get spots like this in the plus hall at nationals so I was beside myself with excitement. That was until I arrived in the hotel in Utah. I picked up my program book and like most callers looked to see who was in front of me at my Plus spot. And, of course, you've figured out it was Jerry Story. I called my dad's room and he picked up the phone and I said "Sh*t"... That was all. Apparently he'd looked too and said, hey, at least you're gonna have a good crowd. UGGGGGGGHHHH!!!!!! (That actually turned out to be incorrect).

At all national conventions you have to sign into the room 45 minutes ahead of time or lose your spot. As I arrived in the monstrous hall I noticed square after square running into the room to get their spot. At first there were about 5 squares in the hall. But within 10 minutes prior to Jerry's spot there were now 100. I'm watching the convention center room fill up with excited dancers waiting to get to dance to Jerry for 10 minutes. Where did they all come from? By the time Jerry walked up the stairs onto the giant stage there were now about 150 squares on the floor. There was an insane buzz in the hall. He plugged in his mic and simply said "howdy". And the crowd yelled back "howdy". Then Jerry did it again. He yelled "howdy" and the crowd screamed back "howdy". My heart was pounding. I was afraid to look down at my chest because I knew I'd see my heart beating through my body. Jerry said ONE WORD and had the crowd eating out of the palm of his hands. I thought it couldn't get better than this, but it did. Jerry took those screaming dancers and for 10 minutes did what he did best. He had the dancers moving continuously with amazing flow and they were screaming at the completion of every sequence. I was an emotional wreck. By the time he finished the dancers were exhausted and so was I. The room emptied as quick as it filled up which might have been a good thing for me. This was, no doubt the worst experience of my calling career.

I was blown away by the fact Jerry could, in seconds, create an experience for the dancers that could not be accomplished by anyone else in our activity. He was the consummate entertainer.

There were many more exciting things I could share of experiences calling with Jerry and might save them for a later date. I feel blessed to have had the opportunity to work with him. It was truly the highlight of my calling career.

He will be sorely missed but today I put on a CD in the car with me, Jerry, Tony and Pat Barbour from a festival in the 80's in Myrtle Beach and just smiled. Another cherished memory of having the privilege of working with the best in our business.

Square dancing will not be the same without him.

Jerry had been a full-time caller for over 40 years calling in all 50 states and numerous foreign countries. In the square dance world, his was truly a household name. In addition, Jerry and Kristy owned a small bar(The Hideaway) in Fairfield, IA.

Like the rest of the world's full-time callers, Jerry's income completely dried up during the pandemic. In addition, the Hideaway had to close as well. In April, Jerry and Kristy both were hospitalized after being diagnosed with Covid 19. Prior to his death, he was in the ICU Unit of Iowa University Hospital for almost 4 weeks undergoing multiple surgeries, an amputation of his leg, and a barrage of tests.

Jerry had devoted his life to our great activity. His amazing choreography and unbridled enthusiasm has thrilled thousands and thousands of dancers worldwide for almost half a century. He has taught hundreds of callers in various callers schools. He was the pioneer in getting the SSD Program established. He will be remembered as one of the best callers our activity has produced. This is an opportunity for the square dance world to give back. Kristy needs our help. With Jerry's death, Kristy is now saddled with negotiating a growing mountain of medical and household debt. It's New Year's Eve, and finally things are starting to change. Yes, it will still be a few months yet, but we can see the light at the end of the tunnel. By my count there are now 3 approved COVID-19 vaccines and one "emergency" use.

Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccine - first kid off the block. US Moderna Vaccine - close second, US Sinopharm COVID-19 Vaccine - China

Oxford-AstraZebeca Vaccine - UK emergency use This are all two dose vaccines, with several weeks in-between shots.

One promising vaccine still in clinical trials is one by Johnson and Johnson. Unlike the approved vaccines, this one is a single shot, recombinant adenovirus vaccine that uses a live pathogen believed to be 97% effective.

As of tonight, here is the world status on Vaccine Development. Researchers are currently testing 64 vaccines in clinical trials on humans, and 19 have reached the final stages of testing. At least 85 preclinical vaccines are under active investigation in animals.

So what does this mean for square dancing? Well it's only my educated guess, but sometime between May and August of 2021 we should be working back to "normal".
