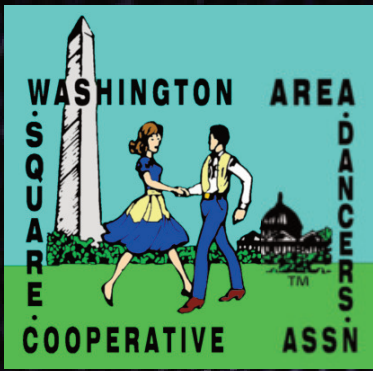


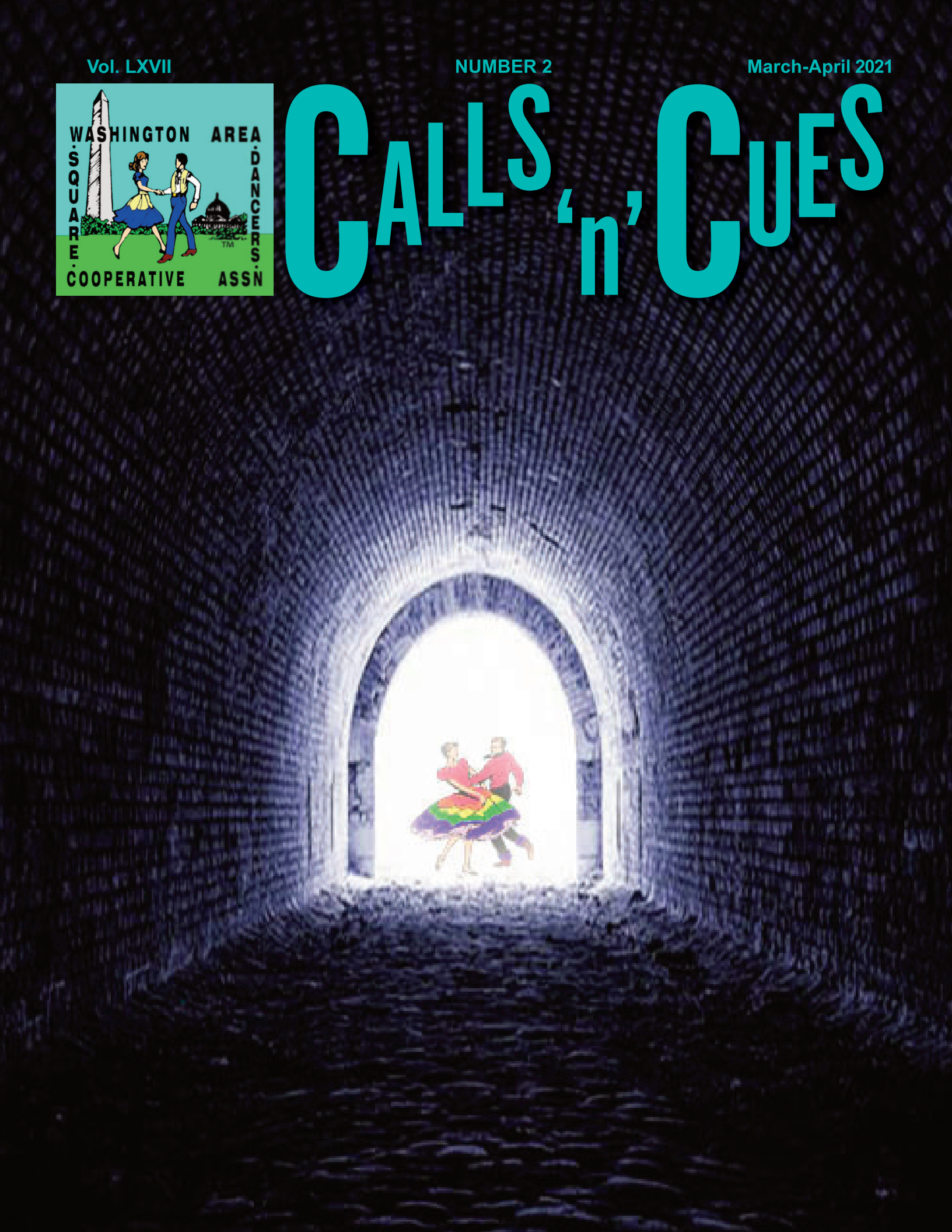

The Editor's Desk

Is the end in sight?

One of the benefits of being the Calls 'N' Cues editor is that I regularly get to email/talk with members of our dancing community. It is quite clear that we are getting vaccinated. Now granted most of the individuals I talk to are in priority groups 1B or 1C, but the majority of them have received at least their first shot. These shots are being obtained from several sources - senior residences, medical facilities such as Kaiser & Inova, and even county clinics. President Biden has just announced that there have been 50 million vaccinations in the first 37 days, so we are well on the way to meeting his goal of 100 million in the first 100 days. With a bit of luck, the reach goal of 150 million might be achievable.

The other good news is that there has been a definite downturn in the number of new cases, and the number of deaths. As a result, Virginia Governor Northam announced he was easing some of the pandemic restrictions. However, if one looks at the numbers closely it is apparent that the downturn in cases/deaths began in early January, before the number of vaccinations should have begun to have an effect. Public health officials attribute the decline to people adhering to the masking, social distancing, and stay at home guidelines. With all the new COVID-19 variants that are coming along that seem like good advice. We all want to get back to dancing. It strikes me that being vigilant for a while longer is a small price to pay to allow us to get back to our favorite past time.

To that end, there is some good news. As you will learn later in this issue, both the 32nd Virginia State Convention in Williamsburg and the 70th National Square Dance Convention in Jackson are still scheduled to be held. In both cases the associated venues will be available if allowed. Unfortunately for club level dances I suspect venues will be a problem for some time to come. I believe it will be a long time before schools open back up to outside groups back in - I don't expect it to be allowed during the 2021/22 school year. My personal guestimate is there is only a 50/50 chance we will gain access senior centers by September. I have no ideas about churches. I strongly recommend everybody keep their eyes and ears open for potential new venues.

And with that I will close. Type you next issue.

From the WASCA President's Corner

(WASCA Presidents 2020-2021)

By the time you read this it will have been a year since we danced with real people rather than these invisible zoom-bots. That dance would have been on Sunday afternoon, March 1, 2020 with caller Doren McBroom.

This thought came up earlier today as we were listening to a USDA webinar when the speaker (Mike Hogan) stated that he thought that 25 to 50 percent of dancers would not return to square dancing – plus we would also lose some callers and cuers. His recommendation was to start encouraging new people now and invite them to some fun/easy dancing events when they are enthusiastic about getting out and socializing again. Mike said that the ideal time for such welcoming events would be about 3 months after CDC lifts all restrictions and people feel safe about resuming activities or starting something new.

Normally we would be focused on the WASCA Spring Festival at this time. As you are aware the 2021 Festival was canceled by the WASCA board last August. So we are now working on the 2022

WASCA Spring Festival. The decision made in August 2020 was a judgement call on the likely state of the covid pandemic in March 2021. At this point we don't know what the situation will be a month from now, but we can compare today's data with March 19, 2020. This would be the Thursday startup date of last year's Festival which was canceled by order of the state of Virginia. On March 19, 2020 the number of new cases reported was 17 and the number of deaths due to Covid-19 was 0 in Virginia. Today there are 3215 new cases and 30 deaths. It would seem that if the Festival was not safe to hold in March 2020 it is certainly not going to be safe to hold it next month.

For the future, the news looks more positive. Looking again at data from Virginia, the 7 day average of new cases has been cut in half over the past 20 days. If this trend continues, we should have a very low number of new daily cases in less than 200 days.

Oh my gosh. Is this pandemic over yet? I think the CallsNCues editor sees a light at the end of the tunnel. Golly I hope so.

I'm sure nobody is surprised that as an organization, NCASDLA members have not been up to very much lately. Never-the-less, we are planning for the end which must be in sight soon.

The verdict on the Virginia State Convention in May is still pending, as is the rest of the Summer plans. Personally, this is how I see it. We may be OK for the State Convention depending on shot schedules and the VA Governor's concurrence. I give it a 30/70 chance of happening.

In Virginia (and I think Maryland) COVID vaccinations are in progress. In the Virginia Senior Living communities like Greenspring in Springfield and Falcon's Landing in Sterling. Most of these seniors have received both vaccinations or will have shortly.

Today I had a Zoom get together for my Greenspring Seniors, five people attended and reported they hope to be allowed out soon. My mom (who is 99 this month) has also received two shots so hopefully we can get back to visiting by Mother's Day.

I had scheduled the Herndon Senior Center for a "WASCA Mini-Festival the weekend of March 18 - 20. I don't believe that is going to happen (Fairfax County would have to open the Senior Center for use which seems highly unlikely).

Our Callerlab Convention the last week in March will be held via Zoom.

Sunday May 16th I'd scheduled a one day, State Convention Trail-in at the Herndon Senior Center. Also, a 30/70 probability of occurring.

Sunday Jun 6th I'd scheduled a one-day, multi-room NCASDLA Festival at Herndon. I'm giving that a 50/50 probability of occurring.

By August I feel confident that we will be returning to in-person dancing. I've been asked to consider a "get back into dancing review the last week-in August". Here's hoping we are all surprised by a rapid return to normality.

I wrap-up on a positive note. The normal flu was basically eliminated this year. Hopefully everyone has learned and embraced habits that will sever us all in the future.





Dear WASCA dancer friends:

Unfortunately, this horrific coronavirus pandemic continues to plague us and severely restrict our ability to directly see and dance with all our WASCA dancing friends. Yes most of our local schools, churches, community centers and other public facilities that our local clubs, festivals and special dance events use for in-person dancing activities remain closed. Normally we would be excited in anticipation of another great WASCA festival to enjoy in March -- but we'll have to wait another year for that to occur. We also had to cancel our RDTA Snowflake Ball for 2021 normally held the 2nd Sunday in February. While some of us are still hopeful that we can have our RDTA Butterfly Ball in late April or early to mid May, that event appears increasingly unlikely unless our local schools and other community centers re-open in sufficient time this spring.

But all is not bad news. Several vaccines have been approved and distributed and a number of dancers, including Berni and me, have had at least the 1st shot or are scheduled to have it. Trends in key covid metrics are moving in a positive, downward direction. We will get through these troubling times, even if that won't happen as quickly as we would like.

We want everyone to remain safe and healthy and get their vaccine shots. If we must continue to miss our dancing friends for another couple of months, we'll be just more excited to see and dance with everyone once we overcome this pandemic. We're still hopeful that Governor Northam

will relax the restrictions on large gatherings to allow us to hold the 2021 VASARDA Convention in Williamsburg on May 20-22nd. We're certainly ready to "Rock and Roll to Virginia State". We are looking forward to having a great time at the 32nd 2021 Virginia State Convention in Williamsburg VA. Dr. Anthony Fauci, director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, was quoted in The Daily 202 of the Washington Post on February 11, 2021, predicting that an "open season" for vaccinations in the U.S. will begin in April and he expects "virtually everybody and anybody" in any category will be eligible to get their shot by then.

With vaccinations increasing, we should be able to hold the Va State Convention. We will still need to follow the CDC and State guidelines.

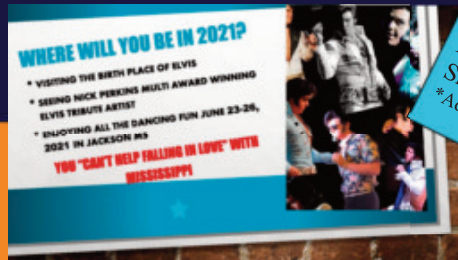

Plenty of ways to stay in Jackson

Plenty of camping, hotel options are available

January 28, 2021— If you haven't registered for the 70th National Square Dance Convention in Jackson, MS, what are you waiting for? It's mere months away, happening June 23-26, 2021, so the time is now.

When you're registering, don't forget about housing. There are plenty of housing options available to you, so you're certain to find one that meets your needs. Make sure you register through the "Housing: Hotels, Camping & Travel" link at 70nsdc.com to get the convention rates from our partner hotels. Hotels will not be taking reservations for the convention directly.

The Jackson Downtown Convention Center Hotel by Marriott is the headquarters hotel. It offers a pool and free complimentary bottled water each day to help you cool off after a long day of dancing. Three more hotels are available within 1.5 miles of the Marriott, and no hotel is more than nine miles away. Prices range from \$80 to \$159 per night. To take advantage of discounted room rates, reservations must be made by May 15.

If you would rather camp instead, the Mississippi State Fairgrounds has sites available, and it is just a mile from the headquarters hotel. Camping is \$45 per night for 50 amp and \$25 per 30 amp, with a 4-night minimum. Most sites have full hookups. A dump station and shower facilities are available.

Any way you choose to stay, you'll be well taken care of. Come join the reunion in the "City with Soul" in Jackson!

Now that people are beginning to get their vaccinations for COVID we should all be ready to get out and dance. Come help us celebrate our 50 years of dancing with our 50th and final Dance-A-Rama festival (with a one year gap). We will celebrate our 50 years at the Airport Holiday Inn in Des Moines, Iowa on Labor Day weekend, September 3rd thru 5th, 2021. The hotel has done extensive remodeling since then and all dancing will be on one level this year. Iowa's State Square Dance Convention was held there in March but, unfortunately, has now been cancelled, the hotel is looking forward to us being there.

We are looking forward to this same outstanding line-up of callers and cuers that were to entertain us in 2020: Callers: **Jack Pladdys (OH), Tim Tyl (TX), Tom Davis (OH) and Travis Cook (KY)**, and Cuers: **Phyllis Burdette (OH) and Bonnie Lawrence (IN)** (with Bonnie also teaching and leading line dances).

I am serving as Chairperson in charge of our festival, and am looking forward to welcoming you back to Des Moines. Come early or stay late and see what you didn't get to see in 2012 or when the National was here in 2016. I am already busy looking for places for us to go on tours. Below are some of the interesting and beautiful sites that Iowa has to offer. The Capitol, Sculpture Park and our Art Center are free. There is a free shuttle that operates in the downtown loop (from the Capitol to the Sculpture Park).

71st National Square Dance Convention® Pre-Convention is first to be virtual

The COVID-19 pandemic has forced events to be cancelled and upended lives, but it has also brought innovation.

The 71st National Square Dance Convention's® Pre-Convention is one example. The event was originally scheduled at Evansville's Doubletree Hotel, but the National Executive Committee (NEC) granted permission to NSDC organizers to hold the Pre-Convention virtually, after they determined COVID caseloads were still too high to hold large gatherings in person. Because necessary planning still needed to happen, organizers decided to use Zoom and make the event the first virtual Pre-Convention.

The event will run four days beginning March 10. The NEC will have meetings and hear reports from the 70th, 71st, 72nd, and 73rd conventions. On Saturday, March 13, there will be breakout sessions beginning at 10 a.m. that will stretch until 4:30 p.m. and reconvene with a wrap-up session at 7 p.m. There will be eight virtual “rooms” that will be renamed after each round of meetings.

There will also be a virtual dance on March 12 beginning at 8 p.m. with callers James Cha and Janet Lewis. Virtual square dances usually have two couples at a time dancing. There will also be at least one game.

While the Pre-Convention is the first to be virtual, plans are still underway to have the 2022 National Square Dance Convention® fully in-person. Keep June 22-25 on your calendars and “Join Us Down By The River” for a memorable convention. Register for the virtual dance and the 2022 convention at 71nsdc.org.

William “Clark” Edwards PhD

May 24, 1925 - January 19, 2021

Clark Edwards, PhD Economic Research Service (Retired), a resident of Greenspring Retirement Community in Springfield, Virginia, died peacefully on January 19, 2021, a few months before his 96th birthday.

A long-time resident of Alexandria, Virginia, Clark was pre-deceased by his wife Rose Szyrwiell Edwards in 2005. Clark is survived by his children, Suzan, Jane (Dirck Harris-deceased), Don (Chun Shi), and Barbara Binder (John); grandchildren, Katherine (Sam), Davis, Ryan, Sam, and Jill (Skylar); great-grandchildren, Ezra, Lorelai, and Lila; and dear friend Reba Heffernan.

Dr. Edwards was born in Chicago, Illinois, the youngest of three siblings, and attended the John Dewey Lab School of the University of Chicago in Hyde Park until he moved to Branson, Missouri in 1937, where he attended the local high school. His family chores included fetching water in pails from the spring to bring to the house and shoveling the outhouse. Clark joined the army and served in the Pacific Ocean Theater as a radio operator in World War II. He met his wife Rose, a registered nurse, in Chicago after the war and subsequently, with the help of the GI Bill, attended a series of colleges and universities. He received a BA from the University of Missouri-Columbia, a Master's Degree in mathematics from Purdue University and a PhD in Agricultural Economics from Michigan State University.

After four years on the faculty at Oklahoma State University, Dr. Edwards and his young family moved to Alexandria, Virginia when he joined the Economic Research Service (ERS) of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) in 1962. While at the ERS he was head of the Demand Analysis Section and then became chief of the Area Analysis Branch, Economic Development Division. He served on the editorial board and later was an editor of the Journal of Agricultural Economics and taught evening classes in economics at the Graduate School, USDA. Clark loved playing his four-string banjo, reading, traveling, and, in his later years, sailing and square dancing.

Clark was exposed to square dancing early - his mother and step-father held weekly square-dances at their Golf Ranch in Branson, Missouri. Clark and Reba Heffernan were special friends and square dance partners. They were members of the Capital Squares Exhibition Team, and danced with many local clubs including Merry Notes, Adam's Apples, Old Dominion Squares and the Greenspring Seniors square dance club. Together they attended many square dance events including the annual Washington Area Square Dance festivals (WASCA), Maryland and Virginia State festivals, and National Conventions - often performing with the Capital Squares. After the Greenspring Seniors Caller left, Clark used tapes and continued to hold the group together until Butch Adams became their caller. Many of us remember his 90th birthday square dance in 2015. He continued to dance with the Greenspring Seniors with Butch, and then Dick Otis. After he could no longer dance due to medical problems, Clark frequently came to watch his friends dance. Clark was loved by all. He will be missed but never forgotten by the square dance community.

June 29, 1922 - December 28, 2020

Mark White, Jr. died peacefully on December 28, 2020 at the Bowie Assisted Living Facility in Lanham, Maryland at the age of 98. Mark was born on June 29, 1922 in Macon, Georgia and was the 14th of 19 children born to the late Mark White, Sr. and Annie Mae Turner. The couple moved to Brooklyn, New York where Mark worked at the Brooklyn Navy Yard as an Electrical Engineering Technician, a part time barber at Oliver's Barbershop on Fulton Street, and as a handyman. With the closing of the Brooklyn Navy Yard in 1970, he relocated his family to Annapolis, Maryland where he worked at the David B. Taylor Research and Development Center until he retired in 1981. After his retirement from the Federal Government, he went on to become a part time bus driver for the Anne Arundel County School System. He drove elementary, middle, and high school children. His passion had always been mentoring and working with young children. During his bus driving days, he received an award in 2008 for being the first Anne Arundel County School System bus driver designated as a Bruin Bully Buster Mentor for Broad Neck High School.

He spent the majority of his retirement traveling throughout the United States and abroad. His hobbies included square dancing, coaching basketball and softball, bowling, tennis, playing bridge, and chess. He also participated in the Toast Masters Club and was a Grand Master at the Annapolis Masonic Lodge Number 89 in Annapolis, Maryland.

For many years Mark and Irene White were active members of the Belair Square Cats as well as past members of Melody Squares and Friendship Squares. Mark also danced with Billy Harrison's advance club and danced challenge level as well. You were always able to find Mark and Irene at many of the club dances and conventions..

Mark lived in Cape St. Claire, Maryland from 1970 until he transitioned to the Bowie Assisted Living Facility in 2017. He attended the Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Annapolis, Maryland where he served as a deacon, sang in the choir and taught Sunday School for many years. Mark was very committed to family. His strong belief in keeping the White Family connected played a big part in the starting of the White Family Reunion in 1983 and in their continuing biannually until this day.

Spring time is just around the corner. Unfortunately, the 2021 WASCA Spring festival is not (just around the corner). The jury is still out on the Virginia State Convention.

Trish and I (and many of you) have our first COVID vaccination. Some of you have had two. It just may be possible that we can do the VA State Convention by May 20th. But if we do, will you be ready? How much have you forgotten in the past year?

During this year the lack of in-person square dancing led to a burgeoning virtual square dance industry. Unfortunately, many callers, and even more dancers decided to just sit things out. As a result, everyone is going to be rusty.

But that doesn't have to be the case. Case in point. I recently ask Steve Kopman if he would come do a virtual dance with me. Steve told me while he has never taken more than two weeks off since he started calling at age 8 or something, he had not called since the pandemic began. Not wanting to miss an opportunity to work with him, I offered to get him set up and started doing Zoom dances. And boy has he gone in deep, learning the technology and staying up to all hours writing choreography "About a hours work for each tip".

Yep, it turns out sight calling to one couple is a new experience for just about everyone, and writing is essential unless you have VERY experienced Zoom dancers. Guess what, not many people meet that criteria.

Steve started with an introduction to virtual, two-couple dancing (aka mini-squares) with one of the couples been phantoms (e.g. imaginary people). Even for his A2/C1+ dancers - not so easy. Steve's mom, Mrs. Lee Kopman, who's husband wrote over 500 calls including many you know so well (Scoot Back, Linear Cycle, Coordinate etc). showed up at Steve's first dance and was blown away by the call - wait for it - Flutter Wheel.

While I've done this before, I encourage you to take the (no risk, no embarrassment) initiative to try out some virtual dancing. You don't even need to go to a live dance, just go to my channel, www.youtube.com/squaredancers and pick out a plus dance to practice on. You can even go directly to a (Dr.) Ben Brown's Tuesday night plus dance to practice with nobody watching at: <https://tinyurl.com/benbrownplus>

We will be getting back to in-person dancing soon! Don't be rusty.
