Do you miss dancing? If so, we have the answer for you. The Virginia Square and Round Dance Association voted on March 18, 2021 to proceed with the 2021 Virginia State Convention to be held May 20-22 2021.

The signs are all looking good for being able to hold the Convention. More dancers are getting vaccinated. Governor Northam increased the indoor occupancy to 50. As we get nearer to Convention time, perhaps the indoor occupancy will be raised even higher. Fort Magruder Hotel and Conference Center will be following all safety protocols.

We received the following information form Bill Saccardi of the Fort Magruder Hotel: Masks are required to be worn in all public spaces per *Wyndham but that could change any day, who knows? All staff at the hotel is required to*

wear masks. The key point to mention is our staff is restricted from entering the event while it is occurring. Again, this may

change in a few weeks so we are all in the boat. We will see where we are in the next few weeks and just communicate.

As an additional safety precaution, we request that all potential dancers and staff be vaccinated by May 5, 2021. We will have hand sanitizer in all dancing halls. Matt Worley is planning a fantastic square dance program. John and Rose Miller are planning a great round dance program. Bob Clinebell will have a Contra program and we plan to have lines on Saturday. We will have baskets to raffle off and "special" items for you to bid on. We plan to all go out to dinner on Wednesday night at a Williamsburg historic tavern. SuzieQ Creations will be at the Convention to create your special name badge. She also has many other items to purchase.

If your 2020 registration was rolled over to 2021, you need to send the 2021 form in to Dick and Sue Murray. This makes sure that you get your packet with the square dance program and other information. Remember to write ROLL OVER on your form. Please make your hotel registration. The flyer will be in this issue. You need to use the code to get the discount rate.

ZOOM STILL AVAILABLE FOR VIRGINIA CLUBS

The VASARDA Board purchased a one year subscription to Zoom. Per Zoom's description "Zoom provides videotelephony and online chat services through a cloud-based peer-to-peer software platform and is used for teleconferencing."

What this means for VASARDA is that the Board can meet electronically and discuss issues and the upcoming convention during the coronavirus pandemic without having to meet in person. It is also a lot easier than driving several hours for a meeting at the Shoney's in Richmond!

Since the VASARDA Board now has a subscription with Tom Stafford as host, we would like to offer Virginia clubs an opportunity to connect with their club members by Zoom.

All that a club needs to do is contact me to set up a meeting date and time and I will schedule your Zoom meeting. I will then send you the secure link and password for the meeting. You can forward it to your members or give me a list to send it to. I will be the host, but will not need to be involved in your meeting. Once a club member signs into the meeting they will enter a waiting room, until the host (me) admits them to the meeting. In the beginning, Zoom meetings were frequently hacked by some who just wanted to cause havoc and interrupt meetings and having a meeting waiting room discourages the interruptions.
