

The Editor's Desk

Things are returning to normal — albeit rather slowly. Several groups have started in person dancing, usually with a request for dancers to be vaccinated, wear a mask and with limits on how many dancers can be on the floor at any one time. The biggest in person dance coming up is VASARDA's Virginia State Convention. They request all attendees be fully vaccinated by 5 May 2021, masks are encouraged and there will be a maximum of six squares on the ballroom floor. The big dance of the summer will be the 70th National Square Dance Convention in Jackson. Since Mississippi has some the lesser restrictions there are fewer state wide restrictions, however the city of Jackson does have a mask requirement, except while dancing. Even so I strongly recommend masks be worn.

Bobby Fuhr has a number of masks featuring the WASCA logo, Route 66 festival, and several other themes. These will provide excellent advertising for both WASCA and the festival at dances. They cost \$5.00 and are available from Bobbi email: bobbifuhr@hotmail.com, phone: 301-926-3955.

Zoom dancing has made the Washington Post. This morning (28 April) while I was reading the local section, I came across John Kelly's column. It was headlined "Zoom' your partner! Fans of contra and square dancing have moved online". The column featured the contra and traditional squares found at Glen Echo rather than the virtual dancing we have been engaged in. From the WASCA President's Corner

CT and Margaret Montgomery (WASCA Presidents 2020-2021)

On March 8, 2021 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued its first set of recommendations on activities that can be resumed by people who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19. While the text refers to activities that fully vaccinated people can begin to resume now in their own homes, it states that more guidance will be given to help people safely resume more activities. This includes "Visit with other fully vaccinated people indoors without wearing masks or staying 6 feet apart".

As of mid-April, dancing seems to have partially resumed. On a couple of web sites there were more than a dozen dances listed for the month of May. These were in states that have fewer restrictions than Maryland and Virginia.

In the last issue of CallsnCues we mentioned that the "data from Virginia indicated that the 7 day average of new cases has been cut in half over the past 20 days." The same happened in Maryland. Unfortunately, this downward trend stopped a month ago in both states

We are still hoping to see a continuing drop in the number of COVID cases with very few cases by late Summer so that dance activity can resume. This would give everyone six months before the WASCA Spring Festival to bring dancing skills back to their previous levels. The Festival will be held at the Hilton Alexandria Mark Center on March 17 through March 19, 2022. There will be seven dance halls operating Thursday evening and eight halls on Friday and Saturday. As always, we will have a great staff of callers and cuers. Plan to come to this and bring your friends. You will not be disappointed.

The month of May will end our term as Presidents of WASCA. Daryl and John Davis will be the incoming Presidents and as many of you know they have great experience based on having held this position in many previous years. Our term was interesting and we learned a lot. The biggest disappointment was the shutdown of club dancing and the cancelation of both the 2020 and 2021 WASCA Spring Festivals. We would like to thank all members of the Board for their support and help over the last two years. We could not have asked for a better team to help us deal with unexpected events and difficulties. In spite of the problems, the term was a lot of fun and credit goes to all on the Board. We are hoping that most of the problems are behind us and that the year ahead will run smoothly and provide great opportunities to dance.









NCASDLA President's Message

Hey folks, it's almost over! Or at least headed back that direction.

Back in February, I gave the chances of the VA State Convention going forward were 50/50. Happily, we are on the right side of that prediction and the Convention is on!

FYI Trish and I prepare the program book for this event. This year that book will be provided electronically.

At this point, many of us have received our COVID vaccinations and in the next month or so, anyone who wants one will most likely have the opportunity. In Virgina, everyone 16 years or older is now eligible.

If you are interested in a private dance, just ask your favorite caller/cuer if they are able to call for you. If you need help finding someone, feel free to reach out to me for help (dick.otis@me.com).

The National Convention in Jackson, MS June 23-26 is also on. Attendance at the Convention will be a good indicator of how things are progressing.

Personally, I'm concerned that neither the VA State Convention nor the National Convention plans to require masks while dancing. I strongly urge you do so anyway.

Also, for your long-range planning, Jim Wass plans to hold the annual Tots4Tots dance on December 12th (2nd weekend in December), again this year at the Herndon Senior Center.

As previously noted, the normal flu was basically eliminated this year. Hopefully everyone has learned and embraced habits that will serve us all in the future.









Dear WASCA dancer friends:

Regrettably this message feels like deja vu all over again. Despite the significant expansion of vaccination shots among many Americans, especially our most vulnerable senior citizens, most of our local schools, churches, community centers and other public facilities that our local clubs, festivals and special dance events use for in-person dancing activities remain closed. But spring is emerging and there appears to be some increasing willingness to begin opening these public facilities. Several local cuers have begun or are planning to begin in-person dancing. The Shottings and the Ryders have continued their "virtual/distance" dancing on Wednesday and Monday nights, respectively.

As we move into later spring and early summer, in-person dancing opportunities are also beginning to emerge. We now expect that we will be able to physically see and dance with many of our dancing friends at the 2021 VASARDA Convention in Wil-



May 20-22 2021 Convention Update by Tom & Nancy Stafford

COVID PROTOCOLS FOR THOSE ATTENDING THE 2021 VIRGINIA STATE CONVENTION (SUBJECT TO CHANGE PER CDC GUIDELINES)

All attendees should be fully vaccinated by May 5, 2021 before attending the State Conven-

All attendees must wear a mask in public places i.e. lobby and hallways. Masks are encouraged but not mandatory in dance halls.

Each ballroom will have a maximum of 50 people i.e. 6 squares with staff. This number will be monitored for safety of all.

Hand sanitizer and disposable gloves will be available.

Hotel will not provide water for the dance halls so bring your own bottles.

Hotel staff will not be allowed in the ballrooms while we are occupying the ballrooms. Ballrooms are for our private function and not public spaces.

The 2021 VA State Convention will be held May 20 – 22, 2021 at the Fort Magruder Hotel and Conference Center in Williamsburg, VA. Check out the flyer on the website at www.vasquaredance.org.

Fort Magruder Inn will have all safety protocols in place. Fort Magruder Inn will work with the 2021 VA Convention so that we can host a safe place to dance. We will follow the current COVID Protocols which will be subject to change if the CDC or Governor Northam releases new guidelines.

The list of the 2021 Virginia State Convention COVID Protocols is in this issue. The most important Protocol is that all dancers need to be vaccinated by May 5, 2021. This will keep our Convention safe.

We will have many events at the Convention. However, we cancelled the Dancer Hospitality Room as this event did not fit the Protocols. There are lobbies where dancers can congregate with the six foot guidelines. All public areas like the hall-ways and lobbies require that everyone wear masks. The ballrooms are for our private function so they will not require masks but a dancer can still wear a mask if they choose.


If your registration was rolled over from the 2020 VA State Convention, you will need to submit a new 2021 registration with the top filled out and marked ROLL OVER on the form. This helps the Registrars know that you are planning to attend so that your registration packet can be made. If you haven't registered yet, please register.

Please make your hotel registration. The information is on the 2021 VA State flyer which is in this issue. You will need the code to get the Convention rate.



The Ghost Riders Square Dance Band Story



The Ghost Riders started in Concord, California with one man's idea. As you know, callers had been using records for a long, long, time. The reason was quite simple really, you see, they could practice anytime without calling a musician. Not only that, but they

never had to worry about where they would take their cue. They'd call a "do-cee-do" at the guitar solo and a "right hand star" at the moment the fiddle took off. that is because the record never changed, it was the same each and every time they would call a tip.


Back in the old days, musicians didn't quite understand the sixteen measure concepts (and many still don't) and how to change a regular country western tune to something a caller could work with. In 1969 Mr. Hal Langer, a square dancer, was interested in square dancing to live bands, but he knew that every time he had a chance to, it was a disaster. Well after a lot of soul searching, Hal came up with the perfect idea of starting his own band!

He understood that he couldn't use regular musicians so he thought, what about square dancers? Hey, that's the ticket, they know the calls, they understand square dancing and all he had to do was teach them how to play an instrument. No problem! All he had to do was teach some people that knew all about square dancing and nothing about playing music--- RIGHT! Sure, that's all.

Well, that's just what he did. They formed a four-piece band and called it the "Ghost Town Echo." Hal played banjo and took the leadership role on for the band. Dorrie, Hal's sister played bass guitar, Jim Starr played guitar, and Kay played fiddle. There was no drummer but the banjo kept a pretty good rhythm. It worked real well and mostly had a bluegrass sound. A few months later, Dan Bright saw the band perform at a local hoedown and found himself hanging around the stage. Hal soon asked if Dan was a musician and then asked him if he would be interested in coming to a rehearsal. Dan did, and soon joined the band. Kay dropped out but Hal's wife, Nancy, returned home from college and became the drummer. Soon after that Jim had to quit because of a work transfer and the band was back to 4 members. In 1972, Hal was moving to Mack, Colorado, to pursue his career in science. Hal called Dan and asked if he would like to keep the band going. After pondering it for awhile Dan asked how would that be possible? Hal said, same way I did, get square dancers, teach them to play, and have fun. Well, Dan did just that. The Ghost Riders Square-dance band was formed. The logo (Ghost on the horse holding a guitar) was designed by Bert Swerer, a square dance caller. Before Hal Left, He impressed on Dan Bright, number one-- A Live Square Dance Band was the future, and number two-- The ghost logo had to be the focus instead of the band or any one person. Dan, like an Olympian runner picked up the torch and ran, and man did he! He found four square dancers. One was a drummer named John Moore. The next two dancers were a father and son team, which Dan taught to play guitar. Aron Schneider learned to keep a strong rhythm on his guitar while his son Rudy laid a strong foundation on bass. to round it all off, Dan found a dancer out of Martinez, Calif., Named Gary Spence whom he taught how to play piano. A Band was formed! And keeping with Hal's wishes, Dan called the Band --- The Ghost Riders---.

The GHOST RIDERS had been together for approximately fifteen years when Mr. John Moore decided it was time to retire and lay down those sticks. Keeping with the Ghost Riders' tradition they needed a person that was a square dancer. They brought in an old high school friend that had grown up with John and Rudy. On occasion he would sit in with the band. This would happen off and on throughout the years as a relief drummer for John in emergency situations. He was not only a dancer, but his family had a long line of square dance callers within it. It seemed only natural! His name is David L. Ciccone. Approximately a year later Aron Schneider, the Rhythm guitar player and band manger, had to retire from the band for health reasons. Aron has since passed away. At this time his son Rudy took over as band manager. Rudy Schneider chose to retire about two years after that. He now resides in Ripon California and is doing very well. In 2001, shortly after the Band's Mexican Riviera cruise, David Ciccone retired. He still lives close by and we see him from time to time. After 34 years with the Ghost Riders, Dan Bright passed away suddenly in March of 2006. This was a huge shock to the Ghost Riders as well as the entire square dance world. The remaining Members had a meeting and decided that the GHOST RIDERS MUST GO ON. We have picked up the torch and will carry it forward in memory of DANIAL T BRIGHT our brother.



Obviously people come to square dance conventions to dance, but don't forget to get out into the host city of Evansville and see what this gem on the Ohio River has to offer.

If you're looking for history, the question isn't where to find it, but what era. Angel Mounds State Historic Site is recognized as one of the best preserved Native American sites in the United States. It has 12 earthen mounds built for ceremonial and residential purposes scattered around its 100 acres.

Evansville was also an armory for the United States during WWII, and that heritage is celebrated at the Evansville Wartime Museum. It houses an authentic P-47 airplane, Tarheel Ha, among other artifacts.

Learn about one of the nation's first housing projects, built under Franklin Delano Roosevelt's New Deal, at the Evansville African American Museum.

Movie history was made at Bosse Field, where the film "A League of Their Own," was made. The field offers tours of its facility.

If animals are more your speed, try the Mesker Park Zoo and Botanic Garden. The zoo extends over 45 acres and includes more than 700 animals. Be sure to check out Amazonia, a walk through a South American rainforest.

If you're feeling lucky, check out Tropicana's Riverfront Event Center. It has a 24-hour casino, as well as some of the best views of the Ohio River in the city. For more information on the 71st NSDC, see 71nsdc.org.




boggling. Ralph and Joan believed that as a social activity round dancing should be fun and anyone who ever attended one of their teaches or workshops had the best time ever.

CHOREO CORNER

with Dick Otis

Celebrate! We have finally begun in-person dancing again. Greenspring Seniors, Ryder Seniors, Fluvanna Flutterwheels are all dancing, and of course the 32nd Virginia State Convention May 20th and Nationals this summer are officially on!. Check my NCASDLA President's Corner on (page 5) for additional dancing opportunities.

In celebration of this milestone, I'm going to actually do some Chorography sequences in this issue. Just a note, you do not need a full square, or even a mini-square to practice these sequences. You can do it at home with only one couple.

This month's review is the Plus call Ping Pong Circulate. Here's the Callerlab Definition:

PING PONG CIRCULATE - Starting formation - Quarter Tag.


The movement starts and ends in a Quarter Tag formation.

Each dancer Circulates forward one position along the path shown in Figure 1.

The movement may also be called when there is a left-hand wave in the center. In this case, the path circulated along is as shown in Figure 2.

It should be noted that the Circulate paths are independent of each other.

Therefore, it is possible for only those on the outside path (dancers numbered 1, 2, 3, 4 in Figures 1 & 2) to Ping Pong Circulate or only those on the inside path (dancers numbered 5, 6, 7, & 8 in Figures 1 & 2) to Ping Pong Circulate.



There are a couple of things to know about doing a Ping Pong Circulate.

The first thing is if you are on the outside, you're circulate path follows the back of a center dancer. If you follow the back of the person in the center you will always end up in the correct wave formation (right-hand wave or left-hand wave).

Secondly, if you are in the center wave, your path to the outside follows either a right shoulder pass (from a right hand, 1/4 tag formation) or a left shoulder pass (from a left hand, 1/4 tag formation).

Another way of saying this is for normal couples (boy left, girl right) for a right-hand wave (figure 1) the BOYS are on the OUTSIDE path. E.G. they are on the end of the center wave, and they walk OUTSIDE the girl when they circulate to the end position.


But for the left-hand wave (figure 2) the GIRL is

on the outside path, E.G. they are on the end of the center wave, and they walk out OUTSIDE the boys when they circulate to the end position. This does not feel natural and takes some getting use to (aka "experience").

Doing a Ping Pong Circulate from 1/2 Sashayed couples is even harder and only recommended for die hard DBD dancers!

One last note, if you were taught the center dancers extend and partner trade (a crutch), you were taught incorrectly. It is not a partner trade, it is a circulate. Note in the Callerlab definition: "It should be noted that the Circulate paths are independent of each other". In other words, the Caller can have ONLY the Boys Circulate, or GIRLS circulate.

So let's get out and dance folks!





We have heard of four clubs that are dancing now. Woo hoo! Hopefully more clubs will be dancing soon. The Crossfires; Greenspring Seniors; Lake of the Woods and Fluvanna Flutterwheels have all started dancing. We are excited that clubs are finally dancing again.

At the Delegate's Meeting on February 28, 2021, the WASCA Board voted to waive the \$20.00 dues payment for one year. For the 2021/22 fiscal year, clubs are not required to enclose a \$20.00 check. The 2021/22 club membership renewals are due by the end of May. If you need a membership form go to www.wascaclubs.com and fill out the fillable PDF membership form, save it to your computer with a new name and then email it to us or just print it out and mail it. The information from the membership form will be used to enter the times the club dances: the location where the club dances; the caller and the cuer, and the clubs info contact in the centerfold of Calls 'n' Cues. We also use the current information to get a contact email and phone number so we know how to contact someone if we or someone else needs information. The membership information and annual dues are needed to keep your insurance coverage current. Look in this issue for a copy of the membership form.

The next WASCA Delegates' Meeting will be held on May 2, 2021 (the first Sunday of May!) This will be another virtual meeting as the Lincolnia Senior Center has not opened. This will be the last meeting for the 2020/2021 Fiscal Year. If a club has not been represented at one of the three pre-
