The Editor's Desk

The cover says it all: in person dancing is back. I have just returned from the 70th National Square Dance Convention in Jackson Mississippi (which explains why this issue is a few days late).

Because of the delay, I have not been able to send this issue out for normal proofing by the contributors. Should you find anything that needs correcting, please email me. I expect to put up an updated version in the next week or so.

Similarly, next year's WASCA Festival article is a rerun from the last issue. Once everybody is back from Jackson I expect to receive this issue's article and will update this issue.

While sparsely attended, this year's convention was quite enjoyable. It was a bit sad to see rooms the size of Hilton Mark Center's Plaza A or Plaza B-C with only one or two squares active. I had to really work to get a cover picture of people dancing to the Ghost Riders which didn't show big square size empty spaces on the floor. The picture I finally chose definitely makes the room seem more crowded than it really was.

I went to an education session on dance styling. About half of the attendees were callers thus much of the discussion was on how callers could make the dancing more enjoyable. It included things like the rotation in calls. Except for things like "up to the center and back" most calls have a predominate rotation associated with them - clockwise or counter clockwise. That rotation can vary based on the dancers position. Tony Oxendine, the presenter, maintained that if the caller did not balance the calls, the dancers would be left "wound up" and would come away a bit uncomfortable. He also noted that during patter sequences most callers "sight call". They usually use a dancer of their own gender. Since most of the callers are male, the boy typically ends up having a smoother patter dance. Later in the day I attended a "Girls Power Hour" and was able to notice some difference in how their patter seemed smother for the girls. I suspect that is the reason that while dancing girl, I have had the impression that dancing was harder for girls than boys.

And that is all for this month.

The Herndon Senior Center (HSC) renovation is now complete, and the Center is now available for community partner (e.g. us) use. NCASDLA is looking at the feasibility of doing monthly dances featuring various NCASDLA callers on the Second Sunday of the month, starting in September.

32nd Virginia State Convention, Williamsburg VA 2021

May 20-22 2021 Convention Report

The 2021 Virginia State Convention started on Wednesday evening with dinner at the Chownings Tavern in Williamsburg. It was a nice warm night. It was nice to walk in the historic district. Banners were hung and dancing started Thursday evening. The vaccinated dancers were ready to dance! Expenses were kept down by having a link to the Program Book and Syllabus online. John Miller posted a QR code which dancers could use to download a Syllabus copy to their phones. The dance program was put together just before the convention with a very limited and vaccinated staff committed to being there. Small printed copies of the dance schedule were available. The Directors were nervous about holding the Convention due to the Pandemic. Bill Saccardi at Fort Magruder Hotel worked with the Directors from March 2021 thru the Convention. We had a Craft Take Away demonstration by Donna Klais and a Fashion Show with Sandy Hauser as the MC. Angelica, one of our young dancers who just finished Mainstream, modeled a dress which was crocheted by her Mother. Angelica is the granddaughter of John and Rose Miller. Saturday night after the Convention closed, we had an Afterparty that featured a 1950s VASARDA diner. Steve Arthur was the MC. Nick Capozio, Soo Jin Place, Daryl Davis and Jeff Fuhr (dressed as Elvis) sang songs from the 50s. Bobbi Fuhr and Darrella Deubel were our diner ladies who selected the 50s songs! Darrella and Tom Deubel helped the Convention by managing a donated clothing sale.

We feel that the Convention was a success. We had 184 attendees. This total included 53 Rollovers from the cancelled 2020 Convention. All the dancers seemed happy. They were eager to dance. 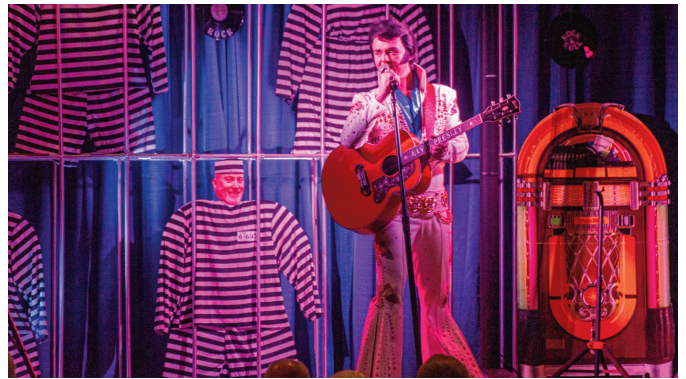

There is just barely two months before the Single Square Dancers USA celebrate our 50 years of dancing with our 50th and final Dance-A-Rama festival (with a one year gap). 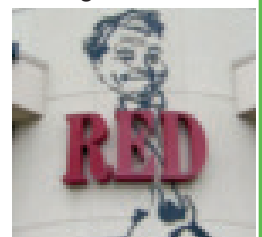

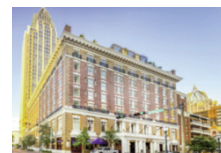

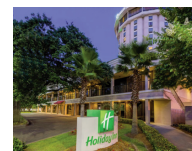

November 6, 1923 — June 4, 2021

(From the minister's comments at his memorial service)

I have discovered two things over the years of arranging funerals or memorial services. The first is that each of us in, in fact, a library and when we die our loved ones and friends lose a library of stories and tales and traditions. The second discovery has been that each person has left an indelible mark on the people he or she loved and related to during life. That becomes obvious in the way stories and memories seem to just pour forth from loved ones. Yesterday after I talked with Ralph's daughter and son-in-law, In our conversation I had been struck by what a full life Ralph lived. It made me think of Henry David Thoreau's words that "Most men lead lives of quiet desperation and go to the grave with their song still in them." That certainly is not true of Ralph. Think about this: He worked for over 20 years with the Army Air Force Exchange Service and then another 12 years as a civilian in the Coast Guard. But here is the information that startled me: At the age of 52 he ran his first marathon, and that was just the beginning of many that he ran. At 62 he travelled the Appalachian Trail from Georgia to Maine. At the age of 69 he was climbing Mt. Kilimanjaro. He travelled to every continent and to all of the national parks. He was proud of the fact that on his expedition to Antarctica he was the only one who did not get seasick.

He danced with many local clubs and was dancing 10 days before his death.

Fred L. Hockenberry

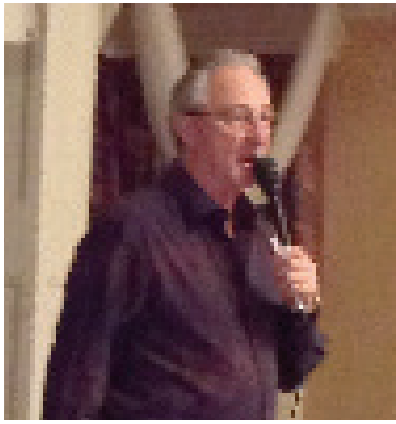
September 27th, 1937 - May 2nd, 2021

The Virginia State and National Square Dance Conventions are now behind us. Yea! Excepting the schools, most square dance venues are now open.

It looks like we made it! (well most of us). We lost some very special people last year who we will always remember. COVID-19 has been a bitter/sweet experience, but for the most part we can start talking about something else for a change.

And that would be square dancing of course! Are you ready?

Many people have not danced in 15+ months. Callers are wondering what to expect. The news is mostly good however. Just like riding a bike, the muscle memory comes back quickly and dancers seem to be snapping back into the grove just as quickly!

From Wikipedia: Muscle memory is a form of procedural memory that involves consolidating a specific motor task into memory through repetition, which has been used synonymously with motor learning.

When a movement is repeated over time, a long-term muscle memory is created for that task, eventually allowing it to be performed with little to no conscious effort. This process decreases the need for attention and creates maximum efficiency within the motor and memory systems.

Muscle memory is found in many everyday activities that become automatic and improve with

practice, such as riding bicycles, driving motor vehicles, playing ball sports, typing on keyboards, entering PINs, playing musical instruments, poker, martial arts, and (of course) dancing!

The muscle memory is an important concept in the Callerlab Standard Basic and Mainstream Applications definitions. Even though Callerlab does not use the term “muscle memory” their definition of standard applications clearly shows this is what they are talking about.

“The listed applications for each call are those from which a caller may reasonably expect close to 100% dancer success.

Experience – Dancers will succeed if they have sufficient previous experience dancing the call from the particular Formation and Arrangement used. Comfort and confidence with a move improves with repetition. The Formations and Arrangements that callers tend to use most often may, therefore, be defined as Standard”

Our biggest challenge is just getting people to come back and dance again. We are out of the habit and need to re-adjust our schedules accordingly. Fortunately (I guess) we are in the normal summer-time lull for most clubs. September should bring normality back to our dance community. You can help by bringing along some friends to join the new square dance classes. Not only will that help re-build or activity, but it will give you a chance to quickly get back in the grove?
