It's good to see that many of the clubs have continued to be operational and have renewed membership in WASCA for the next year. We know that many clubs had to change venues or make different arrangements with the dance location, sometimes incurring additional expenses. We appreciate all the effort that they have made to ensure that dancing continues in Virginia and Maryland.

There are still some occasions in which a club had to cancel a dance because of concern about the safety of the dancers due to COVID issues. We hope that this will not be necessary for much longer and that normal schedules can be resumed soon but please continue to be safe.

Looking ahead, Festival Directors, Ginny Fromel and Rene and Mike Hermann, are already planning a wonderful Festival for next spring so keep the dates in mind - 2023 WASCA Spring Festival (Dancing through the Cherry Blossoms) will be March 16-18.

After a long three years of being the NCASDLA President during the "COVID" era, I will be stepping down this month. A new slate of NCASDLA officers and a BOD (or two) will be elected at our annual meeting July 17th. It's been an honor to hold this office during the time of NCASDLA's re-invigoration. Here are a few of our accomplishments.

NCASDLA grew our membership to 26 callers and cuers.

We provided sound equipment to the WASCA festival this year after their two-year COVID hiatus.

Working with WASCA and NCASDLA's financial assistance, we purchased four brand new Hilton MA-220 amplifiers. In combination with NCASDLA's owned equipment and equipment (some borrowed each year from the membership), this means future WASCA festivals will have MA-220s (or larger) in each hall for future years.

NCASDLA has also been approached about helping sound the Star-Spangled

Banner festival in July.

For three years NCASDLA has waived membership fees for qualified Callers and Cuers. We also provided three weekend caller school (with a 4th one schedule for this year). These caller school are conducted by two of the top Callerlab Accredited Caller Coaches (of which there are only 35 in the world), Mr. Bill Harrison and Mr. Tom Miller.

We changed our schedule for local callers at the annual WASCA spring festival. In addition to two hours of Plus dancing, we added two hours of Advance calling. This includes prime time calling on Friday morning and evening calling Saturday night. This year there was a pretty impressive turn out for all four hours.

I look forward to a growing, vibrant and talented group of NCASDLA caller and cuers in the future.

If you are a Caller or Cuer in the area and not yet a member, please reach out and join us!

t's summertime again in the DC area with temperatures and humidity rising. AC in the venues open to dancing makes summer dancing feasible and fun. While many clubs go dark during the summer, particularly those that dance in local schools, several round dance clubs are able to continue dancing in their regular year round facilities. In Maryland, the Filardo's will be dancing on Tuesday evenings and the Buchanan's on Thursday evenings. RDTA still hopes to hold its annual Butterfly Ball featuring phase II-IV dances later this summer, perhaps the end of August, at the Lincolnia Senior Center. When final plans and arrangements are completed, we'll distribute a flyer with the exact time and date electronically through the WASCA dancers portal,

The 71<sup>st</sup> NSDC Committee, also known as the "River Rat Brigade," thanks everyone who helped in the planning and execution of the convention, but most of all, to the people who attended it. We hope you all had a good time and plan on coming to future National Square Dance Conventions®. A big yellow rock to the bands that provided live music, The Ghost Riders Square Dance Band, Critter Du Jour, and Supertrad.

The GSI caller school had 48 callers attend to hone their skills. Eight squares of dancers braved the 99-degree heat to dance to Kristy Williams at the Market on Main Flash Mob Demo Dance. John and Carolyn Cook, General Chairman, cut the cheese to start the convention.

# CHOREO CORNER I Learned About Calling from...

#### with Dick Otis

In my other avocation, Flying, we often tell stories about our experiences. One of the most famous columns in Flying Magazine is titled: "I Learned About Flying From That" where pilots fess up to things they did that they probably don't want to do again.

Likewise in Square Dancing, we all have experiences that help us learn to dance (or call) better. On one hand, you need to learn the fundamentals well before you move on to the next level. On the other hand, if you are not learning something new then eventually you will probably get bored. There is a delicate balance between these two views. Some dancers want a challenge; some dancers just want some exercise and friendship.

At a recent WASCA Caller Clinic, the legendary caller Jerry Story gave us new callers some of his lessons learned on how to call to make square dancing better. Here is a recap:

- 1. Many callers still call "Stop and Go" patterns; stop and go calling is not good calling. There are many reasons for this type of calling, but often it is because the caller is pacing to the weakest dancers on the floor. Jerry maintains that "Stop and Go" began at higher program levels where calls are more complex. Eventually, it flowed down to even the beginner classes. The goal should be smooth dancing with dancers on the balls of their feet and the sound of shuffle on the floor to the beat of the music.
- 2. Jerry hit on one of my biggest complaints, which is, callers who use their thumbs on the mi-

crophone to shift the music volume up and down as they are calling. I remember one caller at a WASCA Spring Festival who practiced this to an extreme. Every call, he would turn the music volume way down, make the call, and then turn the music volume way up. I found this so irritating that I never went back to dance to him again. Music should be set at a comfortable level and then left alone.

- 3. Callers to frequently use the call "Forward and Back". The problem is callers do not allow the full count of 8 for the dancers to perform the call. The definition is: Dancers join hands with those next to them, walk forward 3 steps, pause, walk backwards 3 steps, and pause. Unfortunately, in today's dancing this call is often executed as a four beat call (e.g. balance up and back). The best use of this call is to a signal that any square that has broken down can get started again by making normal Facing Lines and joining the sequence in progress.
- 4. One thing we probably all agree on, it the overuse of the call Square Thru Four which was the topic of my April Choreo Corner. In summary, there are a lot of options to Square Thru Four and callers are best advised to limit its use.Dosado is another overused call (my note: especially in singing calls).
- 5. Finally, Jerry is the number one fan of the 50-call program, what he calls "sustainable square dancing" initiative. This is an effort to change the most prevalent approach to recruiting, teaching, and retaining new dancers. It is based on his ex-

perience "in lowa showing that teaching fewer calls more thoroughly, retaining new dancers in the entry level for a longer period, and exposing them to a broader range of call application provides greater success. To quote Jerry, "Square dancing is supposed to be entertainment, not a professional trade".

Back to my opening statement, "On one hand, you need to learn the fundamentals well before you move on to the next level. On the other hand, if you are not learning something new then eventually you will probably get bored."

The new things you should be learning however, are not necessarily the calls at next Callerlab program level. Dancers sometimes ask me about moving up to the next program level, but whether that's Plus or Advance or higher, I invariably give the same response. You need to be very comfortable and proficient dancing at the level you are at, before you seek higher ground.

I'd like to wrap up with a report from Steve Kopman about his recent trip to Japan that says a lot about the level of Mainstream dancing in the US.

"Sunday I was scheduled to call mostly Mainstream. That makes me a bit anxious for two reasons: #1) I don't get to call a lot of Mainstream at home. We simply don't have a lot of dancers in the U.S. at that level. #2) These are NOT your typical Mainstream dancers. How do I know that? How many Mainstream dancers in the U.S. can do an 8 chain 3 1/2? How many could do "in reverse order Spin Chain Thru"? Or how about, in reverse order Pass the Ocean? Or how about Skip the 1st part, Slide Thru? How about a tip where you use NO HANDS and dance Relay the Deucey or Spin Chain and exchange the Gears? These are the things I called on Sunday. And don't forget they don't speak ENGLISH so I can't give them hints. Now I'm not saying all 16 squares got it the 1st time, but 90% did. And the other 10% got it the 2nd time. So, let me ask you this? How many Plus dancers in the U.S. could do those calls & concepts? "

So the next time you decide to sit out a Mainstream tip, maybe you shouldn't. It's just something to think about. Happy dancing!
