OUR CALLING STAFF

TOM MILLER



Tom Miller lives in a small community located in Western Pennsylvania. He is a full-time modern western square dance caller who turned his favorite hobby into a full time operation. Tom calls the Callerlab list, Mainstream through C-1. He has traveled throughout the United States, Canada and Europe averaging 75-100 thousand miles per year.

Tom works locally calling for the Mt. Top Squares of Ebensburg, Richland Squares of Johnstown among others in Pennsylvania. He also calls for a mentally handicapped group called the Hilltop Squares. Tom meets so many friendly people in his travels and regards square dancing as FRIENDSHIP SET TO MUSIC.

BILL HARRISON



Bill was born and raised in the Baltimore, MD area. His interest in Square and Round dancing began at the age of 7. In 1970 he began to start calling and then attended a summer caller's school conducted by Mac Parker, this beginning a career in calling.

Bill maintains a full program at home that includes clubs in the Southern, Maryland, Baltimore, and Northern Virginia areas. These clubs range from Plus to Challenge 2. He has a total of 5 clubs and reserves one night a week for lessons. Besides the home program, Bill travels just about every weekend. His travels have taken him to 44 states, 3 provinces of Canada, England, Sweden, and New Zealand.

A member of Caller Lab since 1977, and NCASDLA his area caller association since 1972. Bill is currently on the Board of Governors of Caller Lab. He currently records for ESP / Jo Pat records.



MIKE SEASTROM

I've been dancing since 1960 and calling since 1963. I lost a bet to my mother who insisted that I try square dancing at least three times. The third time hooked me.

I taught my first class in 1963 after borrowing money from my folks to buy a small sound system. I was able to pay them back before the class was over. I've been calling ever since!



I call and teach Basic through C-1, prompt contras, and also enjoy dance party events. I currently teach for the Buckles & Bows.

Calling has given me the opportunity to travel extensively in the United States, Canada, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Germany, Costa Rica, New Zealand, Australia, and Japan. I still feel "dancing as a team of eight" is the best recreation in the world.

I'm a practicing dentist so calling is an avocation very different from my "Dr. Mike" side. Thankfully, my wonderful wife Lisa, my family, and staff have been a tremendous support.



KEN RITUCCI



Ken has been dancing and calling since 1975. In 1983, after attending numerous callers' schools with Al Brundage and Earl Johnston from 1975 to 1982, Ken was asked by Al and Earl if he would help them with their school the following year.

Since 1983, Ken has been instructing callers. In 2004, Ken began his own Callers School, the Northeast Callers School in Manchester, New Hampshire. He has had as many as five schools throughout the country in one year.

Recently Ken has conducted clinics for the Rochester Callers Association, the Santa Clara Callers Association and the San Diego Callers Association. Ken is usually on Panel Discussions at the National Convention each year. He has conducted numerous day-long seminars at Callers Associations throughout the country.

Ken is an Accredited CALLERLAB Caller-Coach, receiving his accreditation in 1991. Among the topics ken specializes in is "Understanding Music and Rhythm," "Salesmanship Skills for Callers," "Understanding Sight Calling and how to be a successful Sight Caller" as well as other topics. Ken calls through the C3B Level and has traveled all over the country as well as Canada and overseas. He is available for calling dates throughout the United States and overseas as well as teach at your Association's clinic or seminar.

OUR CUEING STAFF

WAYNE & BARBARA BLACKFORD

Wayne & Barbara started Square Dancing in 1965 and Round Dancing in 1972. They began teaching in 1974.

In 1997 they became one of the first Round Dance Teachers to become a ROUNDALAB TEACHER/COACH, of which they are very proud, and in 1998 they were presented with the ROUNDALAB'S 2nd highest award, "THE SILVER CIRCLE AWARD". They also are the featured clinicians shown on the original Roundalab Video tapes as well as the addendum tapes.



As full time Round Dance Teachers, they winter in Mesa, Arizona (teaching beginners through Phase VI) for the past 10 years. During the summer months, they travel extensively around the country and Canada conducting clinics, workshops and teachers' seminars.

Their family includes two daughters, Lauri & Kathleen; sons-in-law Ken & Dale, granddaughter Kristen and grandsons Anthony & Austin.



CURT & TAMMY WORLOCK



Curt started round dancing at the age of 13, and began cueing at 16. Tammy met Curt when she attended one of his beginner classes at the age of 16. Curt has been cueing for 33 years.

Some of their past choreographies are "Starlight," "Patricia Cha," "Heavenly Waltz," "Wounded Heart," "Hola Chica," "Where Or When," "Adagio," and "Jack Is Back." "Jurame"

is a Roundalab Classic, "Sugar Sugar" a Roundalab Golden Classic, and "Last Night Cha" was the 2011 ICBDA Hall of Fame dance.

They received the Golden Torch Award for outstanding contributions to Round Dancing in 2009. Along with their 9 Boot Camp DVD's, they have also produced a series of DVD's currently consisting of 12 Volumes titled "Private Lessons With Curt & Tammy".

They opened their own dance hall, the "Stardust Dance Center", which features a 5,500 square foot floating hardwood floor. As owners and managers of the Stardust Dance Center, teaching locally and abroad, and maintaining the

Tom and Ellen met while dancing at a RD club in NJ in 1994. They began teaching together in 1997, and continue to dance and teach together today. They were married in 2001. They have cued and taught at National Square Dance Conventions, Roundalab conventions, ICBDA conventions, and numerous regional conventions and events.

They have cued in 23 states and currently cue and teach Phase I-VI in PA, DE and MD.

Tom began teaching in Germany in 1975. Ellen began cueing and teaching in 1983 in Utah.

Tom has been a member of ROUNDALAB (RAL) since 1977, Ellen since 1984, and together they have belonged to the International Choreographed Ballroom Dance Assn (ICBDA) since 1997. They served on the Roundalab Round of the Quarter Committees for Phases IV, V, and VI. Tom was a member of the European Callers & Teachers Assn (ECTA) RD Council for the 17 years he spent in Germany. He was Liaison to ECTA for the European Assn of American SD Clubs. Tom and Ellen were Moderator & Secretary of Northern NJ RD Teachers Assn (NNJRDTA). Ellen was also President of Delaware Valley RD Teachers Assn (DVRDTA) for 3 years.
