EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID

- **1.** When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
- **2.** The remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and the attendant air and room
- **3.** Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle
- **4.** On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately respond and place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid if required. Caller & Dancers should continue as usual while aid is administered.






