Hello Everybody.

The Editor's Desk

Welcome to my second attempt to fill Arbell's shoes. My first attempt, the April Issue, has been out for a month now. The April issue featured two changes. First of all the pictures were in color, and second it was available online, both as a set of .html online viewable files and a single downloadable .pdf file. The reason we are able to get online so quickly is that the software we use to prepare Calls 'N' Cues (QuarkXPress) has the ability to export .html and .pdf files. As long as we are mailing printed copies we will be limited to the current online versions. Once we discontinue the mailed copies we can begin to evolve into issues which are designed for online viewing.

This issue I will continue to make changes. Immediately visible is the cover. I am going to introduce a variation in covers depending on what going on in the dancing world. Last month's cover was the 2020 WASCA Festival flyer graphic. This month's cover features the 2019 Virginia State Convention. I plan to feature the 2019 Star Spangled Banner Festival (the Maryland state convention) on the summer issue cover. I plan to return to featuring the 2020 WASCA festival on the September issue as well as the January, February and March 2020

issues. That leaves the October, November and December issues for which I have no planned cover as of now. I am leaning to having the 2019 45th Toys for Tots on either the November or December covers. I am open to suggestions as to what should be on the other two covers.

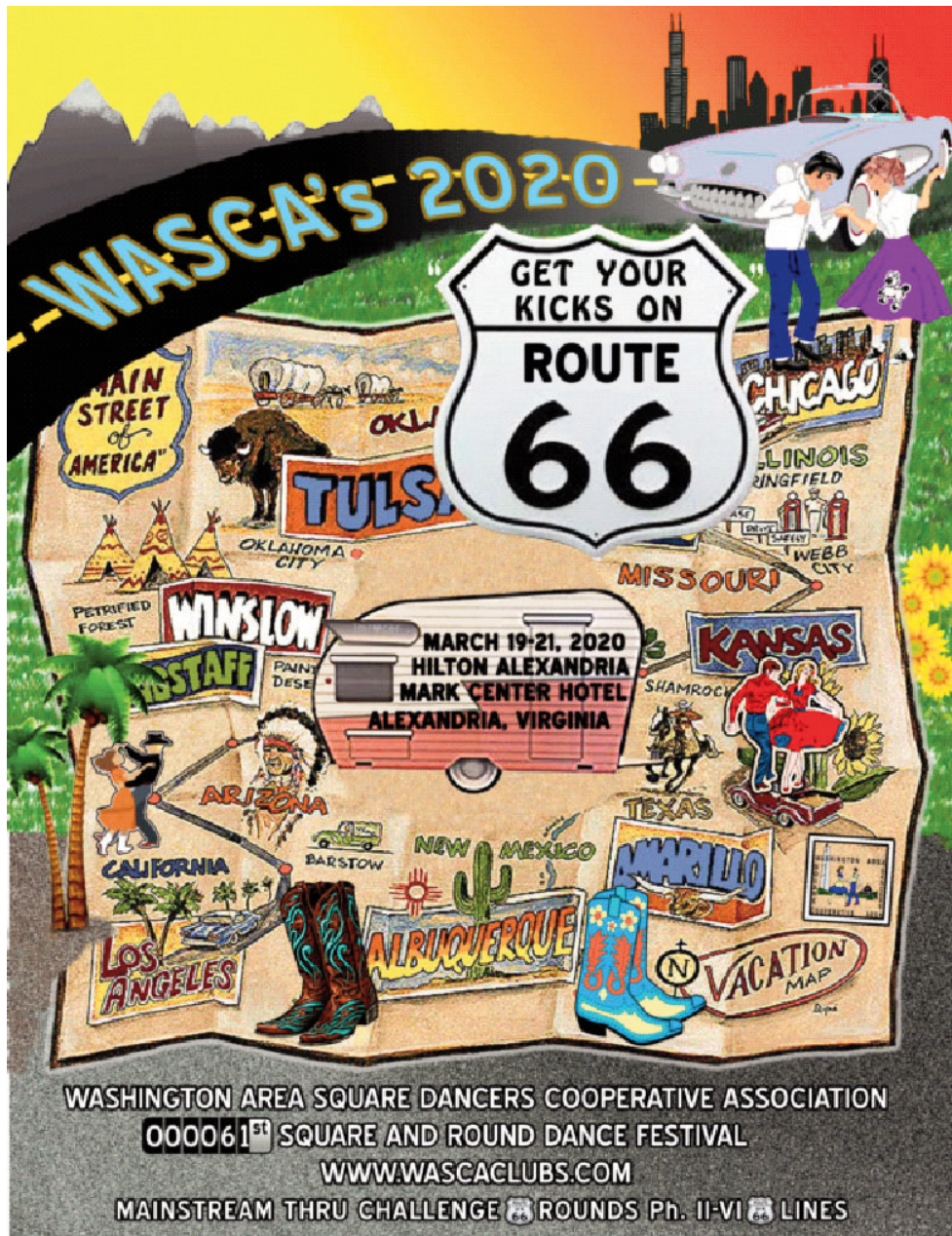
The second change I have made to this issue is not obviously visible. QuarkXPress has something called "styles" that can be attached to text. The most obvious use of styles is the automatic generation of the tables of contents and a list of advertizers. In the future these styles can be used to generate hyperlinks which will allow rapid navigation of the online Calls 'N' Cues.

Remember: The submission cut off dates for the Summer issue is April 15 and July 15 for the September issue. If everything goes as planned the September issue will NOT be mailed out. Once we no longer need to allow time for printing and mailing of the issue I expect to adjust the submission cutoff dates.

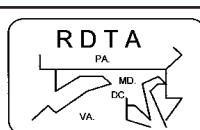

Get Your Kicks On Route 66!

Imitations and Inspirations

If imitation is the sincerest form of flattery, the iconic highway has a fully inflated ego: more than just the TV show has been named after the famous route or inspired by its majesty. The following are examples inspired by Route 66.

Phillips Petroleum Company is an American multinational energy company founded in 1917. By 1925, the company was the country's largest producer of natural gas liquids. Two years later, a car using Phillips gas set the speed record of 66 mph on US Highway 66 in Oklahoma, inspiring the name change to Phillips 66. The first Phillips 66 gas station opened November 19, 1927 at 805 E. Central in Wichita, Kansas, where the local historical society preserves and maintains it. The company shield logo copied the route signs.

The Inland Empire 66ers are a minor league baseball team in San Bernardino, CA; they are currently the Class A Advanced affiliates of the LA Angels. Originally known as the San Bernardino Spirit, they changed their name to the historic route's that ran through San Bernardino. San Manuel Stadium is their home stadium.

The Oklahoma City Blue is an NBA G League team and minor league affiliate of the Oklahoma City Thunder. Founded as the Asheville (NC) Altitude in 2001, they moved to Tulsa in 2005 and renamed themselves the Tulsa 66ers. The purchasers, Southwest Basketball, LLC sponsored a name-the-team contest and received 1200 entries. The name is a reminder that Route 66 ran through Tulsa only a mile from the Expo Square Pavilion where the team played. After nine seasons in Tulsa, the team relocated to Oklahoma City in 2014 and became the Oklahoma City Blue.

John Steinbeck drove from Chicago to the West Coast in 1939 and lovingly dubbed his route "the long concrete path". His trip inspired *The Grapes of Wrath*, a tale about Dust Bowl farmers and their families migrating west to greener pastures. Steinbeck called the route "Mother Road", a symbol of flight, exodus and rebirth.

The route was dedicated in 1952 to Will Rogers, the movie star famous in the 1920s and '30s for cowboy roles. Many public works bore his name after his tragic death in an aviation accident in 1935. I-44 in Oklahoma, which runs along the US 66 alignment, is known as Will Rogers Turnpike.

I Learned About Calling from

In my other avocation, Flying, we often tell stories about our experiences. One of the most famous columns in Flying Magazine is titled: "I Learned About Flying From That" where pilots fess up to things they did that they probably don't want to do again.

Likewise in Square Dancing, we all have experiences that help us learn to dance (or call) better. On one hand, you need to learn the fundamentals well before you move on to the next level. On the other hand, if you are not learning something new then eventually you will probably get bored. There is a delicate balance between these two views. Some dancers want a challenge; some dancers just want some exercise and friendship.

At a recent WASCA Caller Clinic, the legendary caller Jerry Story gave us new callers some of his lessons learned on how to call to make square dancing better. Here is a recap:

1. Many callers still call "Stop and Go" patterns; stop and go calling is not good calling. There are many reasons for this type of calling, but often it is because the caller is pacing to the weakest dancers on the floor. Jerry maintains that "Stop and Go" began at higher program levels where calls are more complex.

Eventually, it flowed down to even the beginner classes. The goal should be smooth dancing with dancers on the balls of their feet and the sound of shuffle on the floor to the beat of the music.

2. Jerry hit on one of my biggest complaints, which is, callers who use their thumbs on the microphone to shift the music volume up and down as they are calling.

I remember one caller at a WASCA Spring Festival who practiced this to an extreme. Every call, he would turn the music volume way down, make the call, and then turn the music volume way up. I found this so irritating that I never went back to dance to him again. Music should be set at a comfortable level and then left alone.

3. Callers to frequently use the call "Forward and Back". The problem is callers do not allow the full count of 8 for the dancers to perform the call. The definition is: Dancers join hands with those next to them, walk forward 3 steps, pause, walk backwards 3 steps, and pause. Unfortunately, in today's dancing this call is often executed as a four beat call (e.g. balance up and back). The best use this call is to a signal that any square that has broken down can get started again by making normal Facing Lines and joining the sequence in progress.

4. One thing we probably all agree on, it the overuse of the call Square Thru Four – which was the topic of my April Choreo Corner. In summary, there are a lot of options to Square Thru Four and callers are best advised to limit it's use.

5. Dosado is another overused call (my note: especially in singing calls).

6. Finally, Jerry is the number one fan of the 50-call program, what he calls "sustainable square dancing" initiative. This is an effort to change the most prevalent approach to recruiting, teaching, and retaining new dancers. It is based on his experience "in Iowa showing that teaching fewer calls more thoroughly, retaining new dancers in the entry level for a longer period, and exposing them to a broader range of call application provides greater success. To quote Jerry, "Square dancing is supposed to be entertainment, not a professional trade".

Back to my opening statement, "On one hand, you need to learn the fundamentals well before you move on to the next level. On the other hand, if you are not learning something new then eventually you will probably get bored."

The new things you should be learning however, are not necessarily the calls at next Callerlab program level. Dancers sometimes ask me about moving up to the next program level but whether that's Plus or Advance or higher, I invariably give the same response. You need to be very comfortable and proficient dancing at the level you are at, before you seek higher ground.

I'd like to wrap up with a report from Steve Kopman about his recent trip to

Japan that says a lot about the level of Mainstream dancing in the US.

"Sunday I was scheduled to call mostly Mainstream. That makes me a bit anxious for two reasons: #1) I don't get to call a lot of Mainstream at home. We simply don't have a lot of dancers in the U.S. at that level. #2) These are NOT your typical Mainstream dancers. How do I know that? How many Mainstream dancers in the U.S. can do an 8 chain 3 1/2? How many could do "in reverse order Spin Chain Thru"? Or how about, in reverse order Pass the Ocean? Or how about Skip the 1st part, Slide Thru? How about a tip where you use NO HANDS and dance Relay the Deucey or Spin Chain and exchange the Gears? These are the things I called on Sunday. And don't forget they don't speak ENGLISH so I can't give them hints. Now I'm not saying all 16 squares got it the 1st time, but 90% did. And the other 10% got it the 2nd time. So, let me ask you this? How many Plus dancers in the U.S. could do those calls & concepts? "

So the next time you decide to sit out a Mainstream tip, maybe you shouldn't. It's just something to think about. Happy dancing!

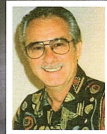

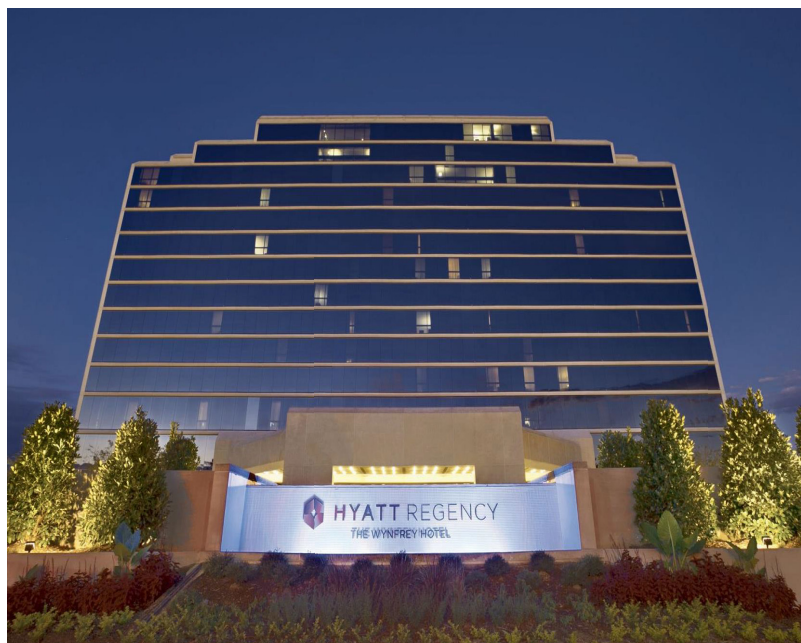

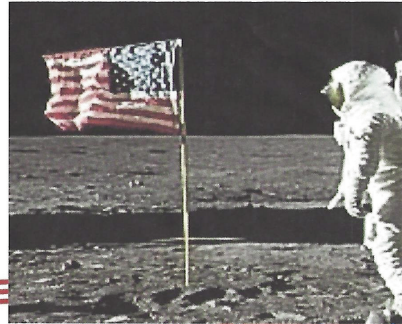
