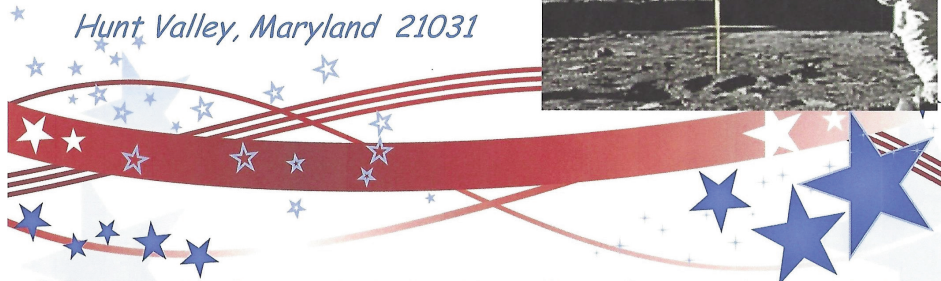
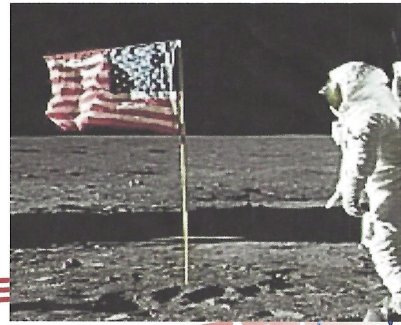

If you wish to arrange for such an email address to be subscribed, please send it to me and I will arrange for Yahoogroups to extend an invitation to join the group. I will also have Yahoo-

groups send an invitation to all current subscribers for whom we have email addresses.

Remember: The submission cut off date for the September issue is August 1 and it is September 1 for the October issue. I know these dates are still rather early for an online publication. However I want to have the extra time as I continue to evolve the format for online publication. Once I have settled into this new format I expect to move the deadline date closer to the publication date.

A valuable resource helping to making next year's festival even better is the survey form. If you have comments or suggestions, please take the time to let us know.

While some of our clubs go dark for the summer, many are still dancing. In addition, there are a number of Festivals and Conventions that are happening during the next few months. The largest event would be the National Square Dance Convention. This will be held on June 26 – June 29 in Atlanta, Georgia. According to the March edition of National Squares E-Magazine, registration for this event is above 3200. This is likely to be the largest National Convention since 2012.

You might enjoy some of the Festivals and Conventions that are happening around the area during the next few months. Events to consider include the NCASDLA June Jamboree Caller-Cuer Showcase held at the Holiday Park Senior Center, Wheaton, MD on Sunday, June 9. Round dancers may be interested in the ICBDA Convention on July 10-13 in Orlando, Florida. The 56th Star Spangled Banner Festival will be held on July 18-20 at the Delta Baltimore Hunt Valley in Hunt Valley, MD. The theme is "SSBF Lands on the Moon". This festival features national callers and cuers and is attended by many WASCA dancers. The West Virginia Dance Convention will be held from July

26-28 in Buckhannon, WV. August starts off with the Tennessee Square and Round Dance Convention. This is held on August 1-3 in Gatlinburg, TN. The North Carolina State Convention will be held on August 16-17 in Raleigh, NC. The 49th National Dance-A-Rama will be held August 30-September 1 in Hoover, AL. This event is organized by the Single Square Dancers USA (SSDUSA) however, all square and round dancers are welcome.

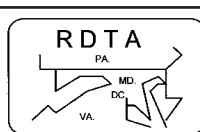

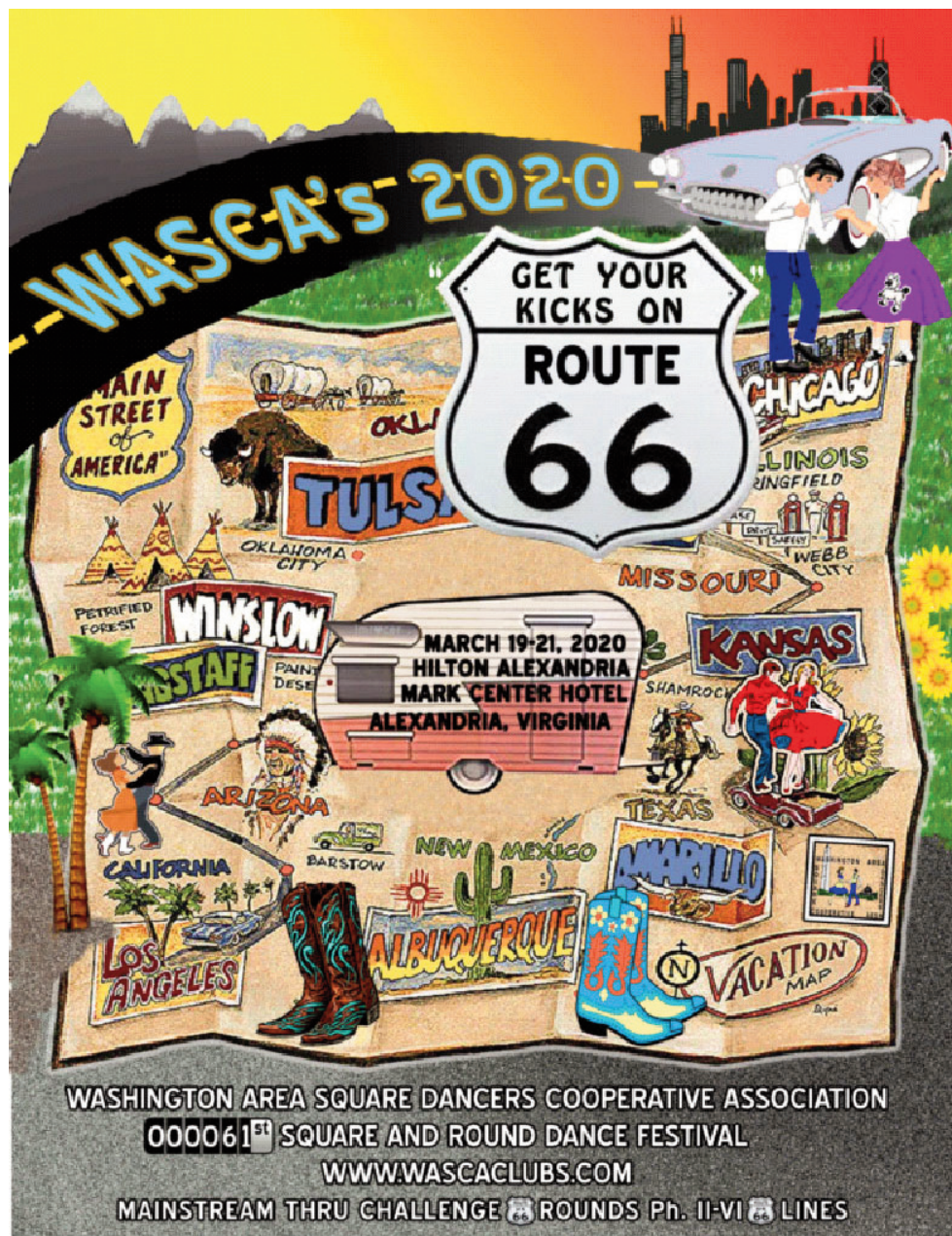

Assistive Listening Equipment at the 2019 WASCA Spring Festival

Assistive Listening equipment was used for the first time at our Spring Festival. The equipment was obtained from Listen Technologies Corporation. Transmitters were installed in four halls: Magnolia, Arbor, Terrace, and Plaza B/C. Each of the halls operated on a different frequency. As far as we know there was no problem with signal reception in any of the halls. The transmitters were installed in the halls on Thursday afternoon at the same time the caller equipment was setup and removed Saturday night after dancing concluded.

Receivers were available in the registration room for dancers who do not have their own equipment. During the Festival two of our receivers were checked out. We do not know how many dancers were using their own equipment.

Highways and Byways

For generations, Americans have piled into family cars, traveling on summer vacation along paved roads stretching from coast to coast. Each of the 50 states owns and maintains a portion of the vast system of US and Interstate highways that make these trips possible.

Interstate highways have the highest speed limits and the largest volume of traffic; they are numbered in a grid: even numbers for east-west routes and odd numbers going north-south. The lowest even numbers are along the Mexico and the Gulf of Mexico; the lowest odd numbers are run along the Pacific Ocean. Three-digit highways are either beltways or spurs of their parent highways.

U. S. highways are the original

interstate highways and date back to 1926. They are also numbered in a grid: even numbers for east-west (lowest numbers along Canada), odd for north-south (lowest numbers along the Atlantic Ocean). Three-digit, 'child' routes, are branches off their two-digit 'parent' routes. US 101 is an exception, considered a mainline US route.

Levels below Interstate and US highways include state and, sometimes, county highways. Interestingly, scenic highways include any class of road and are designate by national and state governments. Indian tribes can also designate a scenic highway.

Happy Summer Everybody!

Callerlab is now behind us this year, and tomorrow Trish and I are off to Virginia Beach for the 2019 Virginia State Festival. Later we are off to Nationals in Atlanta, a couple of weeks in Gatlinburg and Maggie Valley, and finally a square dance cruise to Italy and the Greek Islands. Its' going to be a busy summer.

For the Summer edition I'm going back to an article I wrote several years ago. I think it was timely then, and is still timely today. So here's the flash back - just in case you missed it the first time.

Last year (I'm talking 2015 here) I was attending a week-long square dance. Early in the week the caller was frustrated that simple calls were not working for the some of the squares. He announced that in the next tip, he would only call the following call when everyone was touching the appropriate hands for the formation. The result was predictable – almost every call resulted in a stop, many reminders and then everyone touching hands. Eventually, everyone started to use their hands properly and the rest of the week was an outstanding success.

Hand touching is an essential part of square dancing. From the very beginning classes, dancers should be taught to touch hands in order to provide the security of being where they

should be and more importantly, so they can visualize the resulting formation after the call.

Notice, I am saying hand-touching not hand-holding. There is a big difference. Most dancers fall into one of three types “The No-Touching”, “The Death-Grippers” and “The-Tappers”.

The “No-Touchers” may feel awkward holding hands with the same sex, or they dislike others sweaty hands, or they may have seen the dancer sneeze on their hand. Many “No-Touchers” when asked, say they have been hurt before by other dancers. This dancer does their own thing and everyone else is on their own. The result is the square formation often breaks down – even an experienced dancer can't dance if the other seven dancers are lost.

We all know some of the “Death-Gripper” dancers – they hold on tight and sometimes don't want to let go. To me this is the worse and most dangerous hand-hold. Someone holding on tight is either insecure in their dancing and needs another dancers support, or they have progressed to the stage where they think they are competent dancers and want to “help” other dancers move to the next correct spot in the formation. Either way, if a dancer tries to force another dancer to go where he/she thinks they should go, eventually that dancer or more likely whomever they are holding, is going to get hurt. Size or sex is not as relevant as timing and leverage. At one Advance Level dance, a smaller “experienced” dancer held on to my hand as I turned left – but they wanted me to go right. My arm was twisted behind me, and the resultant jerk on my shoulder resulted in pain for months.

The ultimate destination for dancers should be the finger touch, or “Tapper”. As you dance, reach out

and touch or tap the other dancer's finger-tips. It can be the full four fingers in an "almost hand hold" but the thumbs need to be disengaged. I find that if someone is gripping my hand, I can pull my hand back until I'm just touching their fingers and usually, the dancers will take the hint. Sometimes it is necessary to politely ask them to not grip your hand. I've yet to find anyone who takes offense at a polite comment and many dancers are unaware that they are holding on too strongly.

Now that everyone is lightly touching hands properly, we can talk more about why. The answer of course, is square dancing is a group of people working together for common goals, firstly to have fun together and secondly for the satisfaction of being successful.

What make a square successful? I define it as dancing a sequence smoothly and finishing at your home position with your correct partner. There are two components that work together to accomplish this.

The first is the Caller. He or she is challenged with calling interesting choreography at the appropriate level for the floor, in time with the beat of the music, flowing smoothly from formation to formation and resolving everyone at home. Additionally, the Caller can prove "helper words" to insure the proper outcome. Helper words include hints like: what is the ending formation? (I'm looking for lines), who starts the move? (boys start with your right hand), and who is doing a part of the move? (ladies are casting).

The dancers are the second component. All eight must know the movement of the call and move smoothly from position to position appropriately. Notice I didn't say you must know the definition of the call although knowing the definition is obviously an advantage. We all learn to dance by hearing

the definition of a call and seeing the resultant movement. After a while our body develops motor skills and we tend not to think definitions.

So proper touching is both essential and a key to a smooth square dance sequence that finishes correctly. In squares, especially those with less experienced dancers, touching hands ensures you see the resulting formation. A little "nudge" on the finger-tip is often the difference between a dancer turning in the correct or wrong direction. There is little risk of hurting anyone, since a dancer can easily pull their hand away. You should use nudges sparingly however; some dancer might be offended if used too much – since it implies you don't think they know what to do.

A good example of the importance of touching is the Plus call, Relay The Deucey. This call is a combination of trades and circulates. The center formation of this call is extremely important. If you are in "the wave" moving down the center, you are doing a series of trades (or a cast-off at the end). If you are touching hands in the wave, it's pretty hard for a dancer to wander off from the middle of the formation. Likewise, the dancer circulating around the outside needs to find the person to touch hands with in order to join the wave, or finish the end of the two parallel ocean waves. Touching is even more important, if you happen to be doing say, a left-handed Relay The Deucey.

While regardless of your Program Level (Mainstream, Plus, Advance etc.) touching hand is important and usually results in a successful square. Try it, you'll like it!

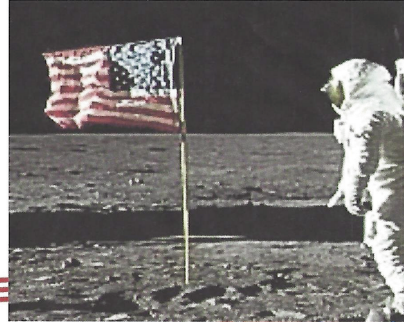
