The Editor's Desk

Hello Everybody

The first online issue of Calls'N'Cues is now history. With this first issue we took advantage of one of the benefits of being online - the ability to quickly change something in the issue. As many of you know, October's RDTA Autumn Leaves Ball is to be held in Maryland this year. In the September issue, the Ryder's RDTA President's message talked about the ball and a copy of the ball's flyer was included in the Special Dance Flyers section. The September issue went up onto the website on 31 August. Not long afterwards, problems developed which required the dance be moved to a second location. On 6 September I received an email from Ken Ryder:

"We had a mini-disaster for our annual 2019 RDTA Autumn Leaves Ball and had to shift to another school in Linthicum MD. I've attached a revised flyer for the Ball and hope it can go in the October Calls 'n cues issue."

Since the September issue was online rather than in print, we were able to edit the issue to correct the RDTA President's message and replace the original flyer with the new flyer

As you found in the last issue, We are now including club and special dance flyers. I have requested "camera ready" 8¹/₂x11 copy. I would like to make an additional request. Calls'N'Cues pages are formatted with a half inch margin around the page. Please create your club and special dance flyers with half inch margins. Flyers with the half inch margins can be put into the issue in a 5-10 seconds. While I will still use flyers which do not have such margins, they take a couple of minutes to put into an issue. Individually this is not a big deal, however when putting several dozen flyers in an issue, the extra time adds up.

Another area where submitters can assist me is in the Calendar of Events section. This section includes events for both the current issue's month and the next month. I.E. the October issue includes both October and November events. When I prepare the next issue I copy the next month's calendar of events entries into the new issue without any changes. (If there are any errors in your club's events please send me a list of corrections). For the next month's events please send them to me as

<date> <club name> - <theme> <caller,level> <cuer,level> - <time> <location> <contact>

I can take a year's worth of events, however I cannot extract the events from your club flyer - most of them are either .jpg or .pdf which the software I use treats as the same thing - a picture. If I were to extract the club events from them I would have retype a lot. One last request: I would appreciate it if any files you send to me include your club name as the first part of the file name. If you don't I need to type the club name when I save the file, which takes more time.

And with that it is time for me to make a final pass in preparation to uploading the issue.

September is a popular month for clubs to offer lessons for new dancers. We noticed that several clubs extend their enrollment period into early October. We know of other clubs that plan startup of new dancer classes in early 2020. There is a tendency for dancers to think about promotion of our activity as related only to activity by their club. If their club is not involved, they are not involved. We would like to suggest a slightly different way to view the issue of promoting our dancing activity. We would also like to offer a similar suggestion concerning promotion of the WASCA Spring Festival to your friends who are in the dance community but do not attend this outstanding event.

Recruiting new dancers. We generally think about this as something we need to do for our club and the class they are starting. If your club is not holding classes, you may think that this is not your issue. We would like to suggest that you think about this differently. You enjoy our dance activity. It feels good to you. The difficulty is that when you are talking to your friends, co-workers, your doctor or dentist, you cannot convey this feeling to them. They need to experience it, and the path to get there is not as short and easy as we would like. I suggest that you think of recruiting someone into dancing as giving THEM a gift. If they do try it and become dancers, you have given them a gift they can enjoy for years. This kind of gift is hard to find and is one of the most valuable gifts you could give anyone.

Promotion of the WASCA Spring Festival. The WASCA Spring Festival has a different feel from most similar events. It's just more fun to attend. Part of this is the effort by the Festival Committee to always make it better with the large number of halls for different levels of dancing, the great staff of callers and cuers and the deco-



rations. Also the downstairs dance halls that exit into an area with a lot of round tables where you can talk to old as well as new friends gives a comfortable feel to the event. These are things that are hard to convey in a conversation, they need to be experienced.

Think of getting dancers to come for the first time not as just increasing the attendance at the Festival, but as a gift to that dancer. One that they can repeat many years into the future. When talking to other members of your club think in terms of attendance at the Festival being a club event. Bring your banner and take back a picture of it hung on the wall. In the past you may have noticed clubs that agree on a place and time for a club picture. Suggest to your fellow club members that they get a group picture at the Festival.



Get Your Kicks on Route 66 Advertising for WASCA's 61st Square and Round Dance Festival

We hope you are making plans to contact club members and businesses you frequent to give them the opportunity to advertise in the Festival Program Book. Your WASCA Club Delegate received a copy of the ad contract in the Delegate's Packet at the September 22 Delegates' Meeting. If you need any information regarding advertising, please use the contact email or phone number on the ad contract.

If you haven't participated in the advertising campaign previously, now is a great time to start. We need everyone to help make this Festival great and we need the money we raise from the advertising to help do that. Does your club eat out before or after a dance? Ask the restaurant if they would place an ad in the program book. Do you have a small business? Advertise it in our program book. How about thanking someone in your club by placing an ad with a personal message? There are so many ways to support WASCA with a simple ad. Don't wait until December to begin the process or you will miss the deadline. Start today – don't procrastinate. Let's see if anyone can sell eight business card size ads – that equals one page and brings in \$200 vs selling one full page ad for \$100. See what combinations of ads you can sell to fill a page.

The ad sizes range from business card size (\$25) to full page (\$100). You can design your ad copy or we can help you with it. If you design your own ad, please look at the requirements on the ad contract so your ad will be truly camera ready. Don't wait too long to begin the process because it does take time to get the program book put together. The sooner you contact an advertiser, the better chance of getting an ad. Local businesses are always looking for opportunities to get their name in front of potential customers. **The deadline for sub-mitting your contract, payment, and ad copy is January 6, 2020.**

Again this year we're offering an incentive to the individual who submits the most ads (\$50) and all those who sell ads will be in a drawing for a \$50 gift card. The person selling the ad must fill out the information at the bottom of the ad contract to receive credit. Be sure your club affiliation is there also.

"There's nothing new under the sun" is a phrase you've heard, as a world-weary complaint about life's monotony; however, traveling along Route 66 in the 1950's was anything but monotonous. Barely seven years after Route 66 opened, Frank A. Redford, a collector of Native American artifacts, added tipi-shaped motel rooms to his shop/museum. After patenting his original ornamental design, he built two more wigwam villages: Horse Cave KY, Cave City KY; copycats later built similar motels in New Orleans, LA, Orlando FL, Bessemer AL, Holbrook AZ and Rialto/San Bernardino CA. The Holbrook motel is located on the current 'Historic Route 66', at 811 West Hope Drive, and has been listed in the National Register of Historic Places since 2002.

Arizona motel owner Chester E. Lewis built his version in 1950, based on Redford's original plans used in Cave City. Lewis liked the motel so much he purchased rights to Lewis's design and the use of the name 'Wigwam Village'. They agreed on a unique royalty payment: Lewis installed coin-operated radios in each wigwam; a dime bought 30 minutes of use. Lewis turned 100% of the proceeds over to Redford.

The Village is arranged in a square, with 15 concrete and steel wigwams on three sides and the office on the fourth, flanked by two smaller wigwams. They are numbered 1-16 (no 13) and, true to their heritage, are called 'wigwams', not rooms or tipis. Each wigwam measures 14' x 32'; behind the main room is a bathroom with sink, toilet and shower. Current rooms include the original (restored) hickory furniture, two double beds, cable TV and a window air conditioner. There are no telephones, Internet access or ice machines. Vintage restored cars dot the parking area and small green benches engraved 'Wigwam Village #6' are scattered around the property.

When the new Interstate 40 bypassed Holbrook in 1974, Lewis closed the motel; his sons

renovated it after his death and reopened it in 1988. The Lewis family continues to operate and maintain the facility. Near the registration desk is a small room used to display their father's memorabilia, including a collection of petrified wood. I f Arizona is not in your travel plans, there are two other Wigwam Villages still operating; four have been razed, closed or replaced.

Village #1, Horse Cave KY: Collectible postcards show six wigwams around a main building with gas pumps; it was closed in 1935 and operated under different names until it was razed in 1982.

Village #2, Cave City KY: Built in 1937, it is also listed on the Historic Register. It consists of 15 wigwams arranged in a semi-circle around a larger structure, originally a restaurant, now closed. Like the Arizona motel, it has no telephones; however, there is cable TV and internet access.

Village #3, New Orleans LA: Built in 1940 in Metairie along US Route 61, it included a restaurant, cocktail bar, souvenir shop and Esso gas station. It went out of business in 1954.

Village #4, Orlando FL: Built in 1948 by Jerry Kinsley, later mayor of Edgewood, this is the largest of the group with 27 guest rooms. It claimed to be 'Orlando's largest and finest motel.' When it closed, attempts to air-lift the some of the tipis to a local YMCA camp failed because the tipis were too heavy. A 330-room Vacation Lodge sits on the site.

Village #6 is the Holbrook AZ motel described above.

Village #7, Rialto/San Bernardino CA: This complex was built by Frank Redford for his private use. It is on the boundary of the two cities, along Historic Route 66. This village has 19 wigwams in a double row; a central building is an office which operates 24/7. A large swimming pool is surrounded by palm trees. The wigwams were renovated in 2005 and the featured zig-zag pattern was restored. It has been listed in the Historic Register since 2012.

Panhandlers Barn Dance for Meals on Wheels of Jefferson County

The Panhandlers Square Dance club held a Barn Dance on September 18, 2019 to raise money for Meals on Wheels of Jefferson County (MOW). The dance held at the Harpers Ferry KOA raised \$800 for MOW. The Panhandlers would like to thank all the dancers who attended the dance. A big thank you to the callers Bob Engel, Art Lavigne, Mike McIntyre, and Carl Odell: and cuers Butch and Roberta Bloxom for donating their time for this event.

MOW's goal is to serve the homebound of Jefferson County, West Virginia. These monies will benefit these neighbors by allowing MOW to use the donations to subsidize their meal costs. Many clients live alone and are on fixed incomes. By design, MOW keeps their minimal meal cost fee as low as possible.

Each meal cost \$8 to prepare and deliver. MOW delivers the meal for \$5 or less. The difference is made up in public and private donations.

MOW prepared and delivered approximately 9,814 noon time meals in 2018. The program is carried out through the efforts of 80 dedicated volunteers, one paid part time cook/kitchen manager, and one paid part time program manager/office administrator.

Many of the MOW recipients are unable to pay the full minimal fee. However, the donations MOW receive subsidize the meal costs so that all recipients receive a hot, nutritious, home-delivered meal daily. This enables these folks to remain independent in their own homes, which is critical. We are a lifeline for many folks who live alone, as the delivery driver serves as a 'well check' (with a) friendly smile and caring person who greets the client daily. The importance of someone stopping by and bringing a hot meal means the world to many lonely clients.





CHOREO CORNER

with Dick Otis

This month lets discuss the Plus call "Follow Your Neighbor", with the goal of understanding what happens if your caller calls "Follow Your Neighbor" three times (see the end).

Most dancers do not have a problem dancing the frequently called "Follow Your Neighbor and Spread" from right-hand ocean waves or more correctly, right hand box formation. We do this at most if not all Plus program dances. Note: "Spread" is NOT part of the call's definition. On the other hand, left-hand boxes can be more problematic.

FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR - Starting formation - Box Circulate, Single 1/4 Tag. TIMING - 6 From a Box Circulate: While the Trailers Extend and Arm Turn 3/4, the Leaders move forward in a tight three quarter (270 degree) circle toward their partner to finish as ends of an ocean wave. Follow Your Neighbor cannot be fractionalized.

From a Single 1/4 Tag: All dancers do the Trailers part (Extend and Arm Turn 3/4).

From a Right-Hand Box Circulate, Follow Your Neighbor ends in a Left-Hand Wave. From a Right-Hand Single 1/4 Tag, Follow Your Neighbor ends in a Right-Hand Wave.

STYLING: Those who Arm Turn 3/4 use a forearm grip, blending at the end of the call into the usual handhold for an ocean wave.

One of the basic tenants of square dancing is recognizing whether you should be looking at a "general line" or for a "box formation" executing any specific call. For this call, we are looking for a box formation (except for the 1/4 Tag formation - let's leave that for the moment).

Assuming the square is in parallel right hand ocean waves, the required action is for the trailers (e.g. the dancer facing in) to drop hands and extend across the box to the other dancer facing in and, with that inside (in this case right) hand you just dropped with your partner, you cast off 3/4. It is critical that you go exactly 3/4 because if you don't the other two dancers (the leaders) will be unlikely to help you find the ending formation; which for this in-

stance is a left-hand wave. Different dancers have different ways to ensure you turn 3/4. Most callers tell you to either count walls (doesn't work for me), or trade and then hinge (marginally better for me). Personally, I like to count out 5 steps - to the beat of the music.

Meanwhile the Lead dancers (those facing out) "move forward towards their partner in a "tight 270 degree circle". If that definition works for you, great. Personally I like to think of this as doing a fold towards your (departing) partner - or neighbor - followed by a roll - or in short, the leaders fold and roll. In this case, they become the ENDS of a left-hand wave. The leaders don't move very far, maybe 18 inches or so, hence the definition's caveat "tight three quarter circle"

The key idea is that the lead dancers should KNOW that if they start from a right-hand formation, then they will end up in a left-hand wave. They should recognize this even before they begin to execute the call. (and vice versa, starting from left-hand formation will end in a righthand formation.)

Note: even though the call Spread is NOT part of the call definition, Callers often call "Follow Your Neighbor and Spread" because that puts the dancers back into a right-hand formation (assuming they started from a righthand box). But it is the dancer's responsibility to know the difference. Hint: that's what makes the sequence at the end of this article hard.

Another variation where Follow Your Neighbor is appropriate is in a right-hand or left-hand column. The call is executed the same way (it is still a four-dancer call). It doesn't matter in the least what the OTHER four dancers are doing, it just LOOKS different because the overall square will end up in a left (or right) handed title wave. (A title wave being, of course, two ocean waves end-to-end.)

Finally, the definition says you can start in a 1/4 tag formation. The definition is the same, but EVERYONE is a trailer. That means EVERYONE does the extend and cast off 3/4. Because there are no leaders in a 1/4 tag formation, a right hand center wave results in right-hand ocean wave at the end.

When we Dance By Definition (DBD) we often fractionalize a call. But the definition for Follow Your Neighbor specifically prohibits this. But not to worry, DBD callers and dancers can still have fun with the call. Take a look at the formation in Figure One: we have leaders (girls) and Trailers (boys). They are in a "funny" formation called T-Bone. If the girls were in a car, about to be hit in the side by a boy in a car, you can visualize where the name "T-Bone" comes from. If the trailers (boys) extend and cast off 3/4, and the leaders (girls) fold left (toward their partner/nearest dancer) and then Roll (Fold and Roll) we will end up in a Diamond formation (Figure Two). Isn't that cool? Well maybe it is not for everyone.

OK well, that concludes our discussion of the call "Fol-

which ends up again in a left-hand wave. This constant refocusing between boxes and lines and left and right hands, can make Follow Your Neighbor 3 times hard to execute! At least until you know how!

HEADS Lead Right, Touch 1/4, Follow Your Neighbor 3 TIMES, BOYS Slide Nose-To-Nose and everybody Promenade Home.



low Your Neighbor". Remember the trailers extend and castoff 3/4 while leaders fold and roll. Starting in right-hand boxes result in a left-hand box at the end of the call, and vice versa. Except for a 1/4 tag starting formation.

Ask your Caller to try this sequence for fun at your next dance. While is this hard? The 1st Follow Your Neighbor takes the dancers from a right-hand box, to a left hand wave. At this point, everyone is focused on forming the correct wave. But immediately the next Follow Your Neighbor requires the dances refocus on their lefthand boxes, and the trailers must start their cast-off with their left hands. Then you are focused on forming the proper right-hand wave. But now you need to focus on your right-hand box for the last Follow Your Neighbor –
