# The Enitor's Desk 

## Hello Everybody

Another month another issue. In general I enjoy editing Calls'N'Cues, with two exceptions: writing this column and assembling the obituaries. I always procrastinate those two chores. As of this writing everything has been completed except the obituaries. Part of my procrastination is psychological - I have known several of the deceased and their deaths have pained me in much the same way as it has others. Also while I knew the individuals, I only knew them through square dancing and know nothing about the rest of their life. Ideally I need three items: 1) a picture, 2) either a written obituary or a link to an online obit, and 3) information on which clubs they danced with and what specific other square dancing activities they were involved with.

Calls'N'Cues is only as good as the submissions that I receive. I begin compiling an issue on the 15 th of the preceding month - on the 15 th of November I will start working on the December issue. In general I would rather not deal with submissions for future issues with two exceptions:

1) Birthdays and Anniversaries - I will accept a file which provides, in date order, several months of birthdays and anniversaries. Should anybody on the list die, please send me an updated file - do not rely on my memory.
and
2) Calendar of Events I will accept a file which gives a date ordered list of club dances or other events. Please start each entry with the date, the club name (in all caps) and the dance theme (if any). After that provide any relevant information. Please see the current month's Calendar of Events for examples. Be aware that I will NOT extract events from Club Schedule flyers.
In general with submissions I would request that the first part of any file names you send me, to include pictures, would be your clubs' name so that when I save them I can easily find them again. Also please provide captions for any pictures.

One last note: at the most recent WASCA board meeting we discussed how to refund subscribers whose subscriptions ended after Calls'N'Cues went online. If you desire to receive a refund email Cecile \& Tim Noyes (Subscriptions@wascaclubs.com) requesting the refund and providing an address to which the refund check should be sent. Cecile \& Tim will calculate the refund at $\$ 1.50$ per unmailed issue and send the information to Linda Peterson who will cut the check and mail it out. Be aware that Linda is getting married early in November, so don't expect checks much before December. Also since it will cost WASCA at least 55 cents postage to mail the check not to
mention bank fees and administrative costs we would appreciate those who are due only small refunds consider the amount to be a donation to WASCA. Also, to allow us to close out our books on 1 June, all requests must be received by 1 April 2020.

And that is it for this issue. Now I need to get to work on the obituaries. Until next month

# From the WASCA President's Corner 

CT and Margaret Montgomery<br>(WASCA Presidents 2019-2020)

While it was not my original plan to cover this topic, I could not stop thinking about it.

On October 11, 2019 Crabtown Squares held its WASCA Theme dance. In addition, Friendship Squares was planning a banner raid at this dance. For most dances we have a standard start time of 7:30 pm for Pre-Rounds and 8:00 pm for Plus $2 \times 2$ dancing.

Since the cuer starts 30 minutes earlier, common practice is that the cuer's sound system will be in place and the caller only brings their computer and microphone. It is not unusual for the caller to arrive after 7:30. We dance at a school in Annapolis, MD. Security requirements of the school as well as the layout of the building result in us having someone to let dancers in from about 7:10 pm until around $8: 20 \mathrm{pm}$. The building is new since it was built next to an old school that has since been removed. A characteristic of the new building is that cell phones do not work inside. From the entrance door we use we cannot hear what is happening in the dance hall.

When the caller had not arrived by around 7:45 one of the Crabtown members came out to phone the scheduled caller. They found out that he would not be able to get to the dance and started the process of checking the availably of other callers. Several people came out to help in the cell phone calling process.

Meanwhile, our solution was inside the dance hall. Among our visiting dancers were David and Donna Cox. We had danced with David and Donna the previous night at Swinging Aces. We talked about other local dances for that weekend including Crabtown the following night and Belair Square Cats on Saturday night. Fortunately for us they made the decision to come to Crabtown. David did not have the equipment he needed in his car but was able
to get it quickly. In the meantime, our cuer, Chris Jopek extend the pre-rounds until David returned. From everything I saw the evening was saved. David's calling combined with the wonderful set of dancers we had visiting that night saved the dance.

More about David. He is a former President of the Metrolina Caller and Cuers Association and serves as the Secretary/Treasurer of the NC Callers Association. You can find more information at http://metrolinadancers.org/david-and-donna-cox/ From Where's The Dance he will be calling at the Swinging Saints Square Dance Club on November 23 in Charlotte NC 28210.(Only about 400 miles south.)

Although David will probably never see this article the only thing I can add is THANKS THANKS THANKS.

This event raises the question of can or should square dance organizations prepare for a scheduled caller not being available. If a club happens to have a club member or visitor who generally attends their dances, they might ask him to act as a backup caller.

A large dance will plan for such a problem. For example, even though we have eight callers on staff for the WASCA Spring Festival we also have a contract with an emergency caller for our March 2020 Festival. This person will be at the festival and ready to step in and call if needed.

Another solution might be the use of recorded or streamed material. For an article related to this you might want to look at "When You Have No Caller" by Buddy Weaver in the August 2019 issue of American Square Dance.

# Get Your Kicks on Route 66 Advertising for WASCA's 61st Square and Round Dance Festival 

It's November!!! That means only four months until the $61{ }^{\text {st }}$ WASCA Festival. It also means only two months until the deadline to submit ads for the program book. Remember that it takes time for new advertisers to get an ad ready so don't delay in asking early. The deadline for contracts and payment is January 6, 2020. Renewing advertisers only need to turn in a contract and payment if they are repeating their ad. If you submit an ad contract be sure your name is on the contract at the bottom so you can receive credit for it. Now get out there and Sell! Sell! Sell!

If you haven't participated in the advertising campaign previously, now is a great time to start. We need everyone to help make this Festival great and we need the money we raise from the advertising to help do that. Does your club eat out before or after a dance? Ask the restaurant if they would place an ad in the program book. Do you have a small business? Advertise it in our program book. How about thanking someone in your club by placing an ad with a personal message? There are so many ways to support WASCA with a simple ad. Don't wait until December to begin the process or you will miss the deadline. Start today - don't procrastinate. Let's see if anyone can sell eight business card size ads - that equals one page and brings in $\$ \mathbf{2 0 0}$ vs selling one full page ad for $\mathbf{\$ 1 0 0}$. See what combinations of ads you can sell to fill a page.

The ad sizes range from business card size $(\$ 25)$ to full page (\$100). You can design your ad copy or we can help you with it. If you design your own ad, please look at the requirements on the ad contract so your ad will be truly camera ready. Don't wait too long to begin the process because it does take time to get the program book put together. The sooner you contact an advertiser, the better chance of getting an ad. Local businesses are always looking for opportunities to get their name in front of potential customers. The deadline for submitting your contract, payment, and ad copy is January 6, 2020.

## GOALS TO BEAT

2018 we had 18 clubs enter 22 baskets for a total of $\$ 1,622.00$.
2019 we had 18 clubs enter 19 baskets for a total of $\$ 1,609.00$.


Although the hit TV series 'Route 66' was filmed in many more states than its namesake crossed, it provided a realistic picture of America in the early 1960s. Route 66, known as 'The Mother Road', enabled Americans to travel great distances for short vacations, experiencing a country much less homogeneous than the one today. Accents, livelihoods, ethnic backgrounds and attitudes varied widely in provincial societies where citizens stayed in the same city, neighborhood and job their entire lives. "Route 66 " was filmed in 25 states, where viewers were exposed to places far from 'home' visually, architecturally and environmentally, where goods and services were entirely different. Chain stores, restaurants and motels had yet to be created, so every journey along the highway, and every episode of the show, widened horizons instead of offering the familiar.
'Route 66' premiered on October 7, 1960 and ran for 116 episodes, ending March 20, 1964. It was an indirect spin-off of ABC's 'Naked City', a similar anthology with each episode filmed on location, and was also inspired by Jack Kerouac's 'On the Road'. Martin Milner starred as Tod Stiles, a new college graduate with an uncertain future, and his friend George Maharis as Buz Murdock. The latter left after three seasons and Glenn Corbett as Lincoln Case, a recently discharged Vietnam veteran, replaced him as Tod's co-star. The two lead characters wandered across the country, acting out various storylines with a changing cast. They took odd jobs along the way, such as grape pickers in a California vineyard, lobster fisherman in Maine and loggers in the Northwest, encountering troubled individuals or dysfunctional families whom they helped. The two buddies symbolized the restless youth of the 60's, searching for life's meaning. Tod represented the well-to-do, clean-cut, decent, all-American type; Buz, and later Linc, were working-class, hipper and more Beat Generation in attitude.

## Route 66 the TV Series

The list of guest stars is impressive: Lon Chaney, Jr., Peter Lorre and Boris Karloff played themselves in a Halloween Special; Ethel Waters was nominated for an Emmy; others include Ed Asner, Elizabeth Ashley, Ed Begley, James Caan, James Coburn, Joan Crawford, Robert Duvall, Barbara Eden, Peter Graves, David Janssen, Buster Keaton, George Kennedy, Cloris Leachman, E. G. Marshall, Lee Marvin, Leslie Nielsen, Susanne Pleshette, Robert Redford (yes, that Robert Redford), Martin Sheen, Rod Steiger, Tuesday Weld and Dick York. William Shatner and DeForest Kelley would become famous in 'Star Trek'; Michael Conrad later starred in 'Hill Street Blues'; Alan Alda guest-starred as a surgeon, presaging his career role as Hawkeye Pierce in 'Mash'.

Nelson Riddle was commissioned to write the instrumental theme song, but CBS decided on a new song rather than pay royalties for Bobby Troup's '(Get Your Kicks on) Route 66. Riddle's song was one of the first tv theme songs to make Billboard Magazine's Top 30, after Ray Anthony's 'Dragnet' theme.

Wikipedia's summary is worth repeating verbatim:
'Despite all the adventure, travelogue, drama, and poetry, the real subject of the series was the human condition, with Tod and Buz often cast as a kind of roving Greek chorus, observers and mentors to broken-down prizefighters and rodeo clowns, sadists and iron-willed matrons, surfers and heiresses, runaway kids and orphans, and other people from all walks of life, forced by circumstances to confront their demons.

One hallmark of the show was the way it introduced viewers to new ways of life and new cultures, for instance, a view of a shrimper's life in episode two of season one, "A Lance of Straw", and a look at Cleveland, Ohio's Polish community in episode 35, "First Class Mouliak". Here, the young are pushed by their parents into careers and marriages they may not want, in an effort to hold community and family together, albeit at the expense of the happiness and well-being of the children.'

Trish and I excited by the arrival of our first grandchild on October 09th. Arriving at 19 inches and 5 lbs 1 $\& 3 \mathrm{oz}$, our new grand-daughter Zoey is the cutest thing in the world - at least our world. We have been a little pre-occupied lately, so this month I'm doing a flash back to my article a few years on Relay The Deucey (slightly modified by a few more years of experience).

I've noticed some dancers can have a momentary relapse on this call, especially when called from an extended application formations such as a Left-Hand Ocean Waves. Lets start by look at the Callerlab's definition.
"RELAY THE DEUCEY - Starting formation - Parallel Ocean Waves. TIMING - 20

All Circulates in this definition refer to the Original Circulate path established by the ends of the original ocean waves. No dancer ever stops moving during this call; the pauses written into the definition (i.e., the action described as "half-circulate") are there for clarity of description and for teaching purposes only.

- Each end and the adjacent center dancer turn onehalf ( 180 degrees). The new centers of each ocean wave turn three-quarters ( 270 degrees), while the others halfcirculate, forming a six-person wave and two lonesome dancers.
- The wave of six, working as 3 pairs, turns $1 / 2$, while the others half-circulate. In the wave, the center 4 turn $1 / 2$, while the other four dancers half-circulate.
- The wave of 6 , again working as 3 pairs, turns $1 / 2$, while the others half-circulate.
- Finally, the center 4 of the wave turn $3 / 4$ (becoming the centers of the new waves), while the outside 4 half-circulate to become the ends of the final waves."

If you put four Callers in the room, they are likely to give you eight different ways to teach this call! Some dancers will relate to one way, others to a different way.

It sounds like this:

1. Everyone Partner Trades
2. The Centers 4 Cast Off $3 / 4$ - while the ENDS $1 / 2$ Circulate
3. The Center 6 dancers (in the title wave) Trade

- while the other End 1/2 Circulates

4. The Center 4 dancers Trade - while the ENDS 1/2 Circulate
5. The Center 6 dancers Trade - while the other End $1 / 2$ Circulates 6. The Centers 4 Cast Off3/4 - while the ENDS Circulate to reform the waves

My first advise is choose the method that works best for you.

Let's dissect the definition a bit, first from a "standard application". Callerlab defines standard application as "those calls from which a caller may reasonably expect close to $100 \%$ dancer success." Variations not listed are considered extended applications.

For this call Callerlab defines the standard formation as a right-hand waves with the BOYS on the ends of the wave, with the note "Called almost exclusively from this arrangement". Why? It's because we are looking for a $100 \%$ success rate.

First, note that Relay The Deucey cannot be fractionalized, e.g. the Caller is not allowed to say "do the first half of Relay The Deucey", or any faction thereof. The definition specifically says "No dancer ever stops moving during this call". There are a lot of simultaneous parts going on and the Caller must be a silver-tongued devil to help you though the movements.

We can however, count the number of moves for everyone in the call, all six of them. My personal preferred method is to count to six as the square progresses through the call. That way you ALLWAYS know went to keep going and when to stop.

Lets give it a go and see how we do. Here goes the Caller "Heads Square Thru Four, step to a wave and everybody Relay The Deucey: partners trade and the centers (boys) cast off 3/4, a girl moves up to join a wave of six, the center six trade, and a boy gets off and the center four
trade, new girl gets on and the center six trade, a boy gets off and the center (girls) cast off $3 / 4$ while the boys move up to the end of the wave. "

Wow, are these hints this really helpful? From my perspective perhaps not so much. To start with, it ignores the end dancer who must walk around the outside by his or herself with nobody else to help them. Secondly, it's a huge torrent of words for which the dancers must pick out the words that apply to them vs. somebody else.

Does it help at all? Well, yes it does. The words are mostly focused on the people getting on and off the end of the waves, and it helps everyone to know when they are done so they don't keep going. But it's not applicable except for this one formation and arrangement.

We can modify the above helper words by focusing on the "Ends" and "Centers" in a gender independent fashion. That would go something like this:

Everybody Relay The Deucey, partners trade, and the centers cast off $3 / 4$ while the Ends $1 / 2$ circulate; the End joins the wave and the center six trade, and an End gets off and the center four trade, a new End gets on and the center six trade, and (to finish) an End gets off, the centers cast off 3/4 while the Ends move up to reform the waves."

I think that's better, but it's still a lot of words. My preference (which, I understand, is not for everyone) would be something that remind the Ends to keep moving on their $1 / 2$ circulates, but then focus on what the Centers dancers are doing:
"Everybody Relay The Deucey, the partners trade, the centers cast 3/4, the center 6 trade, the center 4 trade, the center 6 cast off $3 / 4$ while the Ends reform the wave."

Jerry Story always says, "Lets do my favorite call!" He starts with the same formation above, but adds a Swing Thru to start. I like that because it now feels like a Spin the Top to start; except the in-facing end (boy is this case) does not move into the center of the title wave, he/she just keeps walking around the outside to hook on the end of the title wave.

So lets try it his way: "Heads Square Thru four and Swing Thru, Relay The Deucey! Partner's trade and the center's Cast Off 3/4, 1st Boy On and Swing Thru, Right and Left, Next Boy On and Swing Thru, Right and the BOYS Cast Left 3/4. This allows the Jery to keep a cadence going, focuses on the majority of the dancers, and let's everyone know when they are done with the call.

Now the hardest part of the call is the END Dancers and their $1 / 2$ circulates. I've heard Callers tell the lonesome END dancers to watch their partner moving down the wave, and keep abreast of them for timing. This works well (and is Trish's preferred method, so of course I love it too :). Half Circulates are introduced in the Plus Program in two calls, Relay The Deucey and Coordinate. Of the two, I think that Relay The Deucey is harder because in Coordinate, everyone is doing the $1 / 2$ Circulate, noone moves very far, and everyone has someone to help them.

In Relay The Deucey, the In-facing END dancer is circulating half-way between the waves, e.g. not very far. The Out-facing dancer is circulating half-way around the outside to join the end of the wave.

Likewise the END dancer who is leaving the wave has further to go for their half circulate, but then not very far for their last $1 / 2$ circulate (moving up to the end of the wave). In fact the term " $1 / 2$ circulate" is deceiving because the END dancer just keeps moving around the outside without stopping. The "official" definition even notes: "the action described as "half-circulate" are there for clarity of description and for teaching purposes only.

Up to this point, we've descripted Relay the Deucey with the BOYS on the end (of the waves) to start (standard application) and with the GIRLS on the end to start (extended application). When we are really experienced, we can do the call with BOYS together and GIRLS together to start. AND... we can do it all from Left Hand Waves. In my view NONE of these arrangements are DBD, they are just variations on extended applications - some harder than others.

However you remember to do Relay The Deucey, remember to have fun doing it! After a while doing it form a left-hand wave formation will seem easy. It is after all, exactly the same call, only different. Just remember that everything starts with a left hand, and the END dancers are doing their circulates in the opposite direction.

So go out and have some fun with Relay The Deucey!.
