Route 66, a/k/a Will Rogers Highway, a major US thoroughfare from 1926, covered 385 miles in Arizona......until l-40 bypassed many towns, ruining them forever.

Completed November 11, 1926, 66 ran east to west, from Needles, CA, through Kingman and Seligman in Arizona, to the New Mexico state line. The highway served as a refugee route for "Okies" fleeing the devastation in the Dust Bowl area of the great plains, as ruined farmers and their families escaped their ravaged lands. John Steinbeck's Grapes of Wrath immortalized these travelers. During the mid1900's, 66 , with its new roadside motels, restaurants, businesses and attractions, became a favorite tourist route for American families.

Route 66 in Arizona is particularly picturesque, passing through federal lands, mountains, mining towns and scenic passes. From Needles, it crossed the Old Trails Bridge, Topock Gorge and the Colorado River, in the Havasu National Wildlife Refuge. Heading northeast, it followed the path of the BNSF Railway (former Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway), past Golden Shores (a census-designated place: a concentration of population used by the Census Bureau for statistical purposes), through lands managed by the federal Bureau of Land Management to the foothills of the Black Mountains. After the mining community of Goldroad, 66 crosses the Sitgreaves Pass at an elevation of 3,550 '. Continuing through both mountains and valleys, the route passes the natural Grand Canyon Caverns, among the largest dry caverns in the US. As an aside, these caverns were designated as a fallout shelter during the Cuban Missile Crisis in 1962.

The highway arrives at Seligman, the birthplace of the first Historic Route 66 Association of Arizona. Further along, towards Flagstaff, the road passes through Ponderosa pine forests to parallel the Santa Fe Railway. From Flagstaff, 66 heads towards Winslow, one of the many little towns ruined by the I40 bypass.

## Get Your Kicks On Route 66! Arizona: Route 66 Gives I-40 Takes Away

During the 10 years 1954-64, the Arizona Highway Department spent $\$ 19$ million on Route 66, due to the unexpected and enormous increase in traffic: more than 1 million cars annually, driving from New Mexico to California. The highway became known as the "World's Largest Traffic Jam" and, due to the increasing number of accidents, "Bloody 66". Public opinion objected to the rough and narrow route and associated safety issues, so, in 1954, President Eisenhower endorsed creating a nationwide network of four-lane, divided superhighways with limited access, bypassing cities and towns along its way. The smoother grades and gradual curves would increase traffic flow while decreasing accidents. Congress passed the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1956, creating the Interstate and Defense Highway System. The Act chose several U. S. Highways in AZ as corridors for the new interstates, including Route 66. That was the death knell of towns along 66, whose citizens, businesses and town leaders objected strenuously. I-40 was in fact delayed to allow towns along 66 to adjust. The town of Winslow AZ is a typical tale of boom to bust to better for towns along 66 whose very nature was changed by the 1956 Act.

A thriving town until the 60's, Winslow's downtown businesses and the tourism industry were hit hard by the construction of the l-40 bypass with its national chains like Walgreens and McDonalds alongside. A resident commented "Winslow was the next to last town to be bypassed... We would watch hundreds of trucks roll by day and night. Then one morning, they opened (I-40) and everything stopped. For about 20 years, nobody knew what to do." Winslow continued to deteriorate until, in 1987, a local barber, Angel Delgadillo organized a meeting of 15 small business owners along old 66 ; they agreed to form the Historic Route 66 Association of Arizona and began lobbying state politicians and Better Business Bureaus for support. Delgadillo began selling US66-themed souvenirs at his shop and gained national notoriety. Finally the Arizona State Transportation Board des-
ignated sections of old 66 as Historic Route 66. The ribbon cutting for the new historic route also signaled the beginning of the Route 66 Fun Run, when historic cars drive from Seligman to Kingman. Delgadillo has
been named the "Guardian Angel of Route 66" and "Mayor of the Mother Road" for putting these towns 'back on the map' (pun intended).

December is here! Don't forget to support the 2019 Toys For Tots dance on Sunday December 8th at the Herndon Senior Center from 1-5 PM.

In Chinese philosophy, yin and yang is a concept of dualism in ancient Chinese philosophy, describing how seemingly opposite or contrary forces may actually be complementary. Many natural dualities (such as light and dark, fire and water, expanding and contracting) are thought of as physical manifestations of the duality symbolized by yin and yang.

Applying this concept to our square dancing, most square dances calls have a yin and yang, or the normal way (right-handed) and the balancing left-handed complement call. If you can dance the below sequences, then you are a true Yin and Yang dancer!

1. HEADS Left Square Thru 4, Step To A Left Hand Wave, Relay The Deucey, Allemande Left, Promenade Home. - Technically, instead of calling "Step To A Left Hand Wave, Relay The Deucey" we could just call "Left Relay The Deucey" after the Left Square Thru 4 - but the difficultly level would be higher and probability of success lower.
2. HEADS Right \& Left Thru, Dixie Style, (left) Ping Pong Circulate, CENTERS Recycle \& Square Thru 3, Allemande Left, Promenade Home.
3. HEADS Lead Left, Veer Right, Bend the Line, Left Touch 1/4, Circulate, Coordinate, Everybody 1/2 Sashay, Ferris Wheel, CENTERS Sweep 1/4 \& Back Away @ Home.

4. HEADS Lead Left, Pass To The Center, Double Pass Thru, Left Track Two (Left Shoulders, Boys are on the inside), BOYS Trade, GIRLS Run, Cast Off 3/4, Pass Thru, Wheel \& Deal, CENTERS Left Touch 1/4, Walk and Dodge, Partner Trade, Back Away @ Home.
5. HEADS Step To A Left Hand Wave, (left) Spin The Top, Extend, Left Swing Thru, GIRLS Run Left, Everybody Wheel and Deal, CENTERS Left Swing Thru, LEFT Hinge, GIRLS Run Left.
6. HEADS Left Square Thru, Step To A Left Hand Wave, (left) Spin Chain The Gears, Everybody Circulate, GIRLS Run Left, Chain Down The Line, Wheel and Deal, ENDS Cloverleaf, OTHERS Partner Trade @ Home.
7. HEADS Lead Left, Left Touch 1/4, (left) Follow Your Neighbor, GIRLS Cross Run, BOYS U Turn Back, Promenade Home.
8. HEADS Lead Left, Veer Right, Crossfire, Split Circulate, (left) Coordinate, Wheel and Deal \& Everybody Reverse $1 / 2$ Sashay, CENTERS Face In @ Home.
